

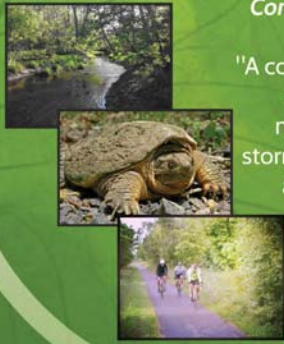




# Philosophy

  - New approach: one approval for the entire watershed
