

**Sub Committee Notes to the Cycling Advisory
Committee November 3, 2015 5 – 6:10 pm Committee Room 3**

Present: Diane Szoller, Jason Jordan, Maureen Zunti, and William Pol

1. Cycling Awards Program:

- We discussed the awards program and are putting forward a recommendation for adoption by the CAC asking that the award be included in the Mayors New Years list of people in the community.
- Diane and Jason are seeking input and direction from the CAC to proceed to discuss the easiest and most effective way for a supporter of the bicycle community to be recognized once per year for their efforts.
- Diane has been liaising with staff to discuss possible approaches.

2. Budget items for 2016:

- It was assumed the CAC would receive \$1500 to support the work of the committee and committee members to advance cycling in London;
- The committee suggested that increments of \$300 - \$500 be made to 5 – 3 activities

Possible investments Include;

- Providing partial support for attending a cycling focused conference
- Partnering with other cycling and health promotion organizations OPPI, Health Unit, In Motion, to bring a speaker to a shared event to generate excitement for popular cycling events such as the cycling festivals in Montreal., the Director of Velo Quebec.
- Supporting CAC member education and knowledge through a tour of cycling infrastructure in Toronto\Ottawa\another GTA municipality with a strong cycling culture to generate ideas for programs, infrastructure and policies.
- Support to cycling education activities

3. Urban Design and Downtown Design Manual review and comments by CAC. No action taken.

- Request that our secretary recirculate the documents requesting comments at our next meeting.

4. Mode Share for Cycling in London

- In the City's Official Plan the actual for cycling is 0.5% 2002 actual and 2% target for 2024. In the Smart Moves document cycling is so small that it is lumped in with walking "today" 9% 2030 target of 15% city wide.
- The Committee contacted the consultants Dave McLaughlin from MMM asking how do we break this out the pedestrian\cycling combination to establish a realistic capital budget request to Council? Comments may inform our budget request.
- The committee is currently supporting a minimum 2% capital budget allocation in keeping with the Official Plan policies target of 2% to 2024.
