## TAC Members:

Our February 2nd meeting will be the only regular meeting of the TAC before the close of budget deliberations at the Strategic Priorities and Policy Committee. For that reason, I would request that members come prepared to make decisions at the meeting about any position we would like to take and feedback we would like to provide on the multi-year budget. I have also been advised that we may choose to hold a second meeting during February for the sole purpose of approving a report prepared after our initial discussion. We can discuss and decide on this option at the meeting.

In order to enter the conversation with as much knowledge as possible, it might be beneficial if people tried to view the presentation given at the SPPC meeting on January 11 when the budget was tabled. Assuming the video is posted before our meeting (and I will send a message to ask about that), it is available at <u>london.ca</u> > City Hall > Meetings.

I know the budget is a bit unwieldy, so I've compiled a list of some of the major items that might pertain to transportation (and particularly those that we've identified as important items in previous meetings). If anyone has identified other items, they can be raised at the meeting as well. Sending them along via email to the committee ahead of time would help as well.

I suggest that at our meeting, we address only those items that members of the committee feel we should provide comment to SPPC on, but let's all come prepared to discuss any/all of these items in an informed way. I have also requested that someone from Finance attend to answer any questions we might have.
