## **RECOMMENDATION**

- 1. That the bid submitted by Dufferin Construction Company, A Division of Holcim (Canada) Inc., 2200 Jetstream Road, P.O. Box 189, London, Ontario N6A 4V7 at their tendered price of \$876,125.00, HST extra **BE ACCEPTED**, it being noted that Dufferin Construction Company is the low bid meeting our terms, conditions and specifications in all areas.
- 2. That Civic Administration **BE AUTHORIZED** to undertake all of the administrative acts that are necessary in connection with this contract;
- 3. That approval hereby given **BE CONDITIONAL** upon the Corporation entering into a formal contract or issuing purchase orders or contract record relating to these matters of this approval.

# BACKGROUND

# **Purchasing Process**

Three (3) bids were received as a result of this tender call February 8, 2012 as summarized in Appendix "A" attached. Dufferin Construction Company is the overall low bid and meets the City's terms, conditions and specifications in all areas.

This contract is for a one (1) year period with the option to extend the contract for two (2) additional one (1) year periods.

### **Purpose**

Tender 12-20 was prepared seeking competitive pricing for the supply of hot mix asphalt to complete road maintenance and repairs to support the Transportation and Roadside Operations Division's annual road maintenance program.

### **Financial Impact**

The total estimated 2012 expenditure for this commodity is \$876,125.00. Subject to Council approval, services rendered under this contract will be funded through the applicable programs identified in the 2012 Operating budgets.
