SUBJECT:	CLAIMABLE WORKS FOR 3313-3405 WONDERLAND ROAD SOUTH SITE PLAN DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT MEETING ON FEBRUARY 22, 2016

RECOMMENDATION

That, on the recommendation of the Managing Director, Corporate Services and City Treasurer, Chief Financial Officer, the following actions **BE TAKEN** with respect to the site plan development agreement between The Corporation of the City of London and York Developments for the creation of easements over the land municipally known as 3313-3405 Wonderland Road South:

- (a) the applicant **BE ADVISED** that the Director, Development Finance has summarized the claims and revenues <u>attached</u> as Appendix "A"; and,
- (b) the financing for this project **BE APPROVED** as set out in the Source of Financing Report <u>attached</u> as Appendix "B".

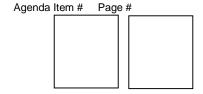
COMMENTARY

York Developments has submitted a site plan application for 3313-3405 Wonderland Road South to gain final planning approvals for the eventual development of approximately 60,000 square metres of commercial space.

Unlike subdivisions, the provisions of a site plan development agreement are handled administratively through delegated authority and most site plans do not involve agreements associated with the construction of claimable infrastructure. For 3313-3405 Wonderland Road South, York Developments will be installing a number of hard services, most of which are the direct cost of the developer according to the local service standards contained in Schedule 8 of the City's Development Charges By-law.

Some of the services to the site are not "local services." City Staff have identified a number of minor roadworks with costs that are eligible to be claimed from the Development Charge (DC) reserve funds. Council must approve and commit funding to enable a future claim associated with the eligible works, as provided in Appendix "B". The anticipated reimbursements from the Funds are:

- (i) for the construction of a concrete sidewalk along the west side of Wonderland Road South from the Bradley Avenue intersection to Wharncliffe Road South intersection with Wonderland Road (Miscellaneous Works -- Sidewalks DC14-RS00069), the estimated cost of which is \$240,000;
- (ii) for the construction of street lights along the west and east sides of Wonderland Road South from Bradley Avenue intersection to Wharncliffe Road South intersection with Wonderland Road (excluding any costs associated with the relocation of existing street lights) (Miscellaneous Works – Streetlights DC14-RS00070), the estimated cost of which is \$195,500; and,



(iii) for the construction of a signalized intersection consistent with the Wonderland Road South Environmental Assessment (including reconfiguration of the London Transit Commission property entrance) and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer (Urban Intersections DC14-00074), the estimated cost of which is \$476,000.

York Developments will also be required to enter into a work plan with the City for the construction of the claimable works, in accordance with the requirements of Schedule 8 of the DC By-law.

CONCLUSION

Although site plan development agreements are handled administratively, there are DC claimable works associated with the site plan application for 3313-3405 Wonderland Road South. The associated development agreement will contain clauses to permit the claims associated with the eligible minor roadworks, which have Capital Budget implications.

Staff are recommending that Council approve the attached Source of Financing in Appendix "B" to enable a future claim for the minor roadworks.

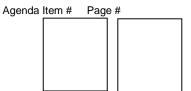

- 1 Estimated Costs are based on approximations provided by the applicant and include engineering, construction and contingency costs without HST. Final claims will be determined based on actual costs incurred in conjunction with the terms of the development agreement and the applicable By-law.
- 2 Estimated Revenues are calculated using 2016 DC rates and may take many years to recover. The revenue estimates includes DC cost recovery for "soft services" (fire, police, parks and recreation facilities, library, growth studies). There is no comparative cost allocation in the Estimated Cost section of the report, so the reader should use caution in comparing the Cost with the Revenue section.
- 3 The revenues and costs in the table above are not directly comparable. The City employs a "citywide" approach to recovery of costs of growth any conclusions based on the summary of Estimated Costs and Revenues (above table) should be used cautiously.
- 4 New requirements of developer constructed works were incorporated into the 2014 DC By-law. The developer ied construction work above will require a work plan to be provided and approved by the City. The work plan should include summary of estimated costs of all Engineering and construction of the works in question.
