- ii. The City give consideration for traffic lights and/or a pedestrian crosswalk on Southdale Road in proximity to this building, prior to the building's opening date.
- iii. During the next revision of the Facility Accessibility Design Standard (FADS), section 4.2.7 be reviewed with regard to the provision of a variable-height change table within any barrier-free washroom or change room provided Note: presently FADS 4.2.7 simply requires that an accessible individual washroom "shall incorporate a change table" at a height no greater than 865mm (34 inch).
