Taxi and limousine operators

Taxi business means a business of transporting passengers by taxi for fares that are regulated by federal or provincial laws. If a provincial government gives its authority to regulate taxi fares to municipalities, the fares are considered to be regulated by provincial law.

A taxi business also includes limousine services, even if they are not metered. For example, a limousine service at an hourly rate that is not metered is considered a taxi business.
