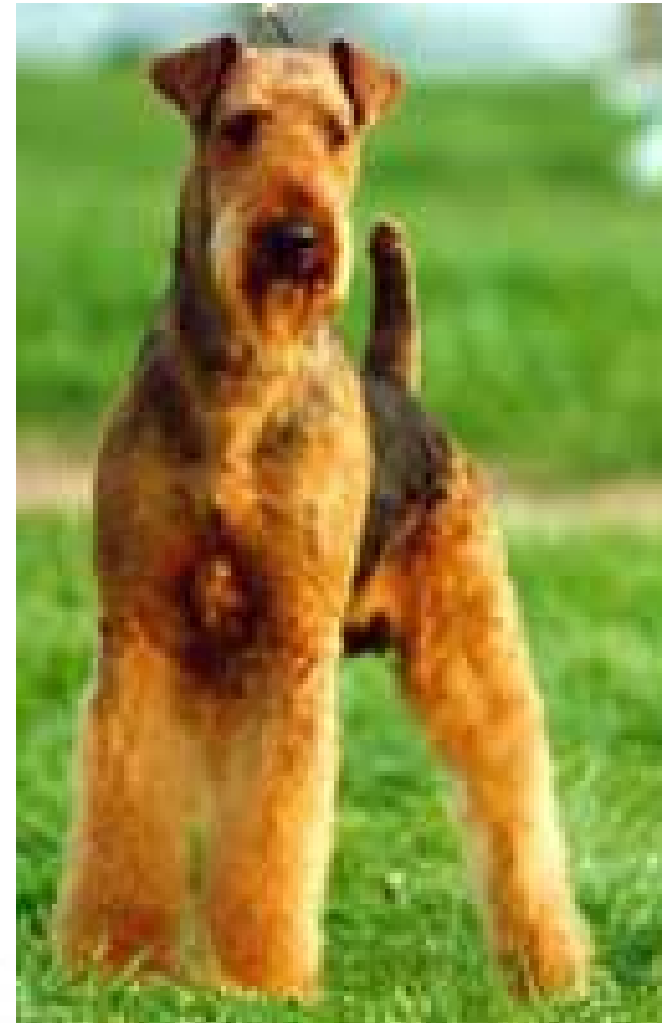

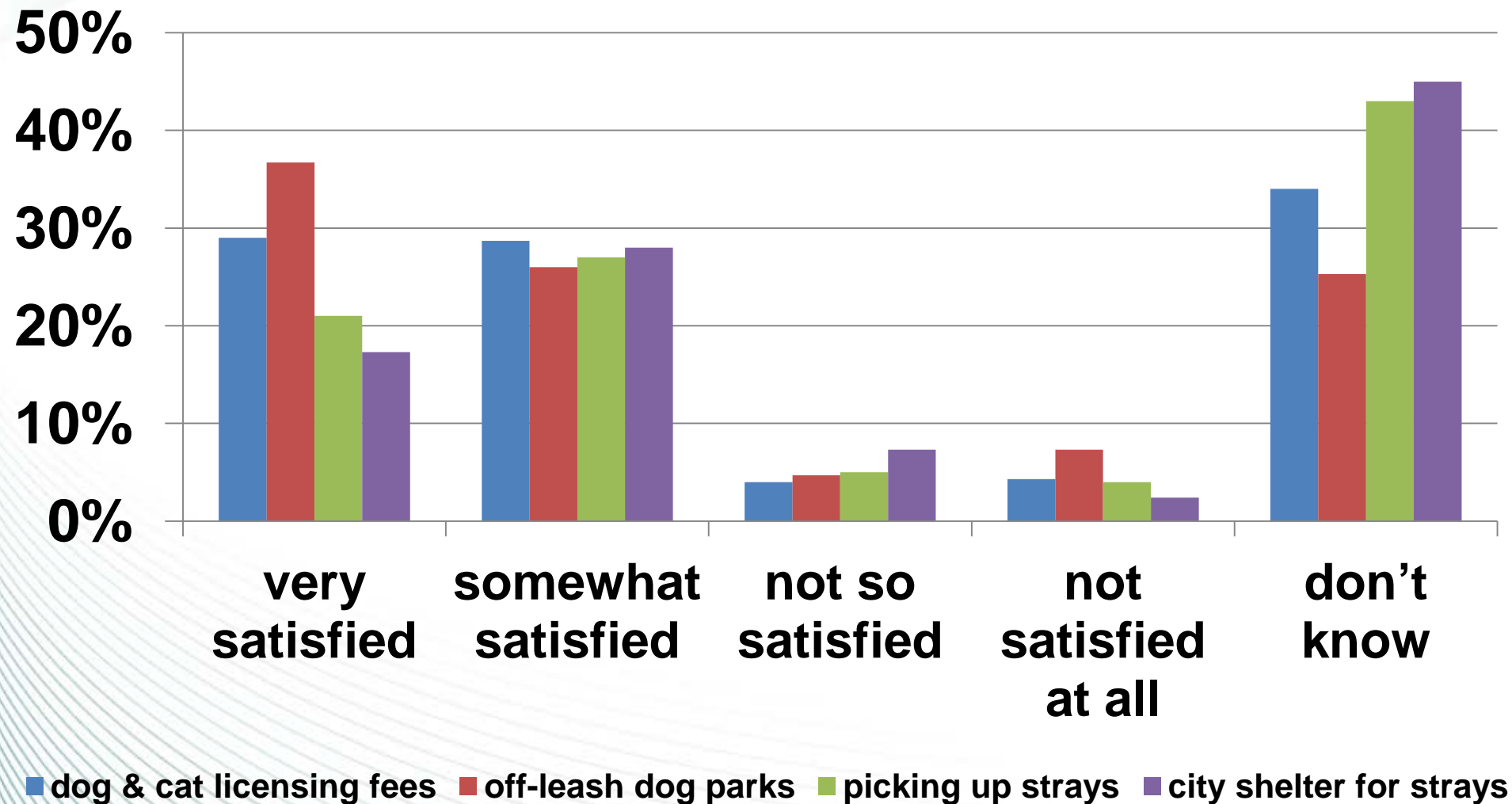


Program Budget – All Services - 2011

| Item | Estimates |
|--|------------------|
| Total Expenditures | \$2,490,000 |
| Total Revenues dogs licensed = 26,449 (up 1% over 2010) cats identified = 12,595 (no change) | \$1,190,000 |
| NET Program Cost | \$1,300,000 |
| Program Cost covered | 48% |
| Net Cost Per Household | \$7.75 |
