Dear members,

Capulet Lane is home to a community park, known as Capulet Park. This park is situated in an area of high residential activity and is constantly used by surrounding residents. To the north and west of the park are several green spaces and links to walking trails are found nearby.

It has been brought to my attention, on several occasions, concerns surrounding the speed of vehicles that utilize Capulet Lane, specifically within the area of Capulet Park. Although there is a curb extension on Capulet Lane near the park, it does not deter drivers; in fact, some vehicles are seen speeding around this extension.

Anticipated residential growth and recent commercial growth, including the opening of Farm Boy, will add to the amount of traffic that utilizes Capulet Lane. The growth in this area has exploded, and will continue to increase as the community is further established.

I would respectfully request that Civic Administration include the intersection of Capulet Lane and Silversmith Street for consideration as a Proposed Type D PXO Location as it relates to item #5, Appendix B.
