#### **SYRIAN GARS ARRIVING TO LONDON**

December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2015 to March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016

#### Purpose of Report:

This report provides basic statistical information on Syrian GARs destined for London, Ontario who received services by CCLC.

#### Organization of Report:

In order, the presented information shows arrivals by date, the share of children and adults (age of majority: 18), a demographic pyramid, a breakdown of children 6 and under, breakdown by family size (1 to 10) and gender breakdown (Male/Female). Education statistics are represented by primary, secondary and post-secondary and employability statistics show a sectoral view of the population's qualifications, followed by years of professional experience.

The format of this report will evolve based on the availability and quality of data from NATS (Notification of Arrival Transmission).

#### Report Period and Arrivals:

This report covers the period of December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2015 through March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016 (Dec 20<sup>th</sup> was the arrival of the first Government Assisted Refugees to London, Ontario). A total of 915 Syrian have arrived to date in London under the Government of Canada's Syrian GAR initiative in the specified time period and have stayed at five accommodations: Marriott, CCLC, EconoLodge, Holiday Inn and London Executive Suites.

IRCC reports that a total of 26,166 Refugees have arrived in Canada, of which 915 came to London, Ontario from December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2015 to March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2015. These people represent 3.5% of the total Syrian Gars admitted to Canada to date and a 10% overall in Ontario.

#### Data Source and Limitations:

Information in this report comes from client data base collecting by RAP staff and volunteers – Figures are subject to change.

#### Acronyms:

NATS - Notification of arrival transmission

#### Ages:

Adults and children have been identified as between the ages of 0 to 17 as children and adults from the ages of 18 to 60 and over.



Chart 1 – Syrian GARs Destined to London by Date and Numbers:





Chart 3 - Breakdown by Ages




Chart 5 – Breakdown by Family Size:



Chart 6 – Breakdown by Gender:




Chart 7 – Breakdown by Education:





Chart 8 – Breakdown by Sector Statistics:





Chart 10 – Breakdown by Gender, Children:





Chart 12: Services: Experience by Profession:



Chart 13: Public Sector, Experience by Profession



Chart 14: Education, Experience by Profession



Chart 15: Trades, Experience by Profession



Chart 16: Farming, Experience by Specialization



Chart 17: Technology, Experience by Profession





Chart 19 – GAR Remained in Temporary Residence:



Chart 20: GARS Moved Out and Still Resident


