Averswood Development Corp. - Site Plan Approval Re:

940 Springbank Drive, London

As you are aware, on September 19, 2011, London City Council passed a Resolution in which it approved in principle the Site Plan for a 165 unit apartment building with 12 floors of residential and two levels of parking subject to six conditions as well as a condition that Ayerswood Development Corp. ("Averswood") enter into a Development Agreement.

By November of 2011 Ayerswood had provided to the City plans for the following:

- Facilities to provide access to and from the land; 1.
- A Servicing Plan; 2.
- A Grading Plan; 3.
- A Landscape Plan: 4.
- Drawings and an Urban Design Brief showing matters relating to the exterior design for 5. consideration by the Municipality's Urban Design Review Panel.

Hydrogeological studies had also been provided to the staff for comment.

Despite numerous requests to municipal staff to be provided with the clauses for the Development Agreement the clauses have not been provided.

Given the length of time that staff have taken to deal with this matter, Ayerswood requests delegation status to address the City's Planning and Environment Committee on Monday, March 26, 2012.
