Our municipality will be liable for law suits under the new act if it goes through this way. The specific problem is that a person using a wheelchair would not be able to safely or independently pass the shelter on the platform without being pushed onto the tracks. This is a very simple fix of widening the platform area or even making a shelter that is not in the way, such as an overhanging cover. Please make this a top priority at the public meeting scheduled for May 26, 2016. Accessibility is not only a human right, it is the law.
