- Sustained an Injury in 2012 meaning 2 years of wheelchair use and life long chronic pain
- Approximately 15 330 (21 %) of Londoners Identify with a disability (Statistics Canada 2006).
- AODA standards do not work due to honour system and a lack of awareness

### The Risk of Inaccessibility



- According to a Forbes formula, Londoners with disabilities could generate approximately \$94.3 million
- Accessible Design works for everyone!

## 3 Step Solution to Implementing Proactive Accessibility into LRT or BRT

- Step 1: Do better to involve local AODA advocates and members of communities with people who identify with a disability
- Step 2: Get involved! Use a wheelchair for a day!
- Step 3: Use person first language
