Bill No. 2016

By-law No. L.S.P.- 3389(_)-___

A by-law to amend By-law No. L.S.P.-3389-65 entitled, "A by-law to designate 3557 Colonel Talbot Road to be of historical and contextual value or interest." (Mathers Cemetery)

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. 0.18*, the Council of a municipality may by by-law designate a property including buildings and structures thereon to be of cultural heritage value or interest;

AND WHEREAS by By-law No. L.S.P.-3389-65 passed on March 26, 2007 Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of London designated the lands described as Part of Lot 74 in Concession West of the North Branch of the Talbot Road of the geographic Township of Westminster in the City of London and County of Middlesex designated as Part 3 on Reference Plan 33R-3853 to be of historical and contextual value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the correct municipal address for the real property designated by By-law No. L.S.P.-3389-65 is 3551 Colonel Talbot Road and not 3557 Colonel Talbot Road;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

- 1. By-law No. L.S.P.-3389-65 and its schedules are hereby amended by deleting all instances of the words "3557 Colonel Talbot Road" and replacing each with the words "3551 Colonel Talbot Road".
- 2. The City Clerk is authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered upon the title to the property in the proper Land Registry Office.
- 3. The City Clerk is authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served upon the owner of the aforesaid property and upon the Ontario Heritage Trust.
- 4. This by-law comes into force and effect on the day it is passed.
