

Fanshawe Park Road/Richmond Street Intersection Improvements Environmental Assessment Study



Notice of Public Information Centre 2

The City of London retained Dillon Consulting Limited to complete a Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study for improvements to the Fanshawe Park Road and Richmond Street intersection. Building on the City's 2030 Smart Moves Transportation Master Plan and Shift (London's Rapid Transit Initiative), the EA Study assessed the need for additional through and turning lanes on Fanshawe Park Road and Richmond Street to improve traffic operation while maintaining pedestrian and cyclist friendly intersection. A map of the Study Area is shown on the reverse.

Public Information Centre 2 will be held on **June 16, 2016**, to present the design options developed for the intersection improvements, comparative evaluation of the design options and the preferred design option.
