The subject property is the north vacant portion of the site located at 7109 Westminster Drive, north of the building which is currently being operated as Fire Station No. 11 by the City of London Fire Department.

The area depicted by the hatching on the map shown on Schedule "A" was the subject of an internal liaison process which concluded that there is no Civic need for the subject property.

Realty Services has received an inquiry from an interested party as it relates to the potential severance and disposition of a portion of the site.

The City of London Fire Department has been consulted and is supportive of the potential sale of the vacant land to the north of the building.

The property will be severed and the surplus portion will be sold via the City's tender process. Legal expenses for the conveyance are to be at the expense of the purchaser(s).

Conclusion

The property is surplus to the needs of the City and should therefore be declared surplus and subsequently severed and sold to the highest bidder via tender at fair market value in keeping with the Sale and Other Disposition of Land Policy.




