- 2. If LHAC decides to form a sub committee / working group a full review of LHAC's mandate.

- 4. Sub committee / working group should create a list for future networking. Example: other advisory committees that have similar mandates that could assist in discussions / liaison.
- 5. Sub committee / working group should identify who they can reach out for assistance.
- 6. A follow-up Education / Outreach joint meeting of advisory committees is planned for Wednesday September 21, 2016 to further discuss ideas and other groups work plans. More information will be provided to our committee secretary at a later date and notes.
- 7. LHAC should decide if they wish to continue attending Joint meetings of Advisory Committees regarding Education / Outreach and who will represent LHAC in the discussions if they wish to appoint another representative.
