RECOMMENDATION					

That, on the recommendation of the Senior Planner, Development Planning Division, Planning, Engineering and Environmental Services Development, the following actions be taken with respect to the resolution of Council in response to an application by The Corporation of the City of London for a street renaming:

- "Cedarpark Drive" on Plan 33M-580 **BE RENAMED** to "Guiness Way" effective May 1, 2012;
- b) The Corporation of the City of London **BE REQUIRED** to pay for the cost of street signage; and
- c) On approval of the street name change, the City Clerk **BE REQUESTED** to introduce the attached By-law at the next available Council meeting to re-name "Cedarpark Drive" to "Guiness Way".

BACKGROUND

On September 26, 2011, the Development Approvals Business Unit in consultation with Cedar Hollow Developments Limited and Auburn Homes Inc., brought forth the special provisions for the subdivision agreement for the Cedar Hollow Subdivision – Phase 2, before the Built and Natural Environment Committee (now known as the Planning and Environment Committee) with the recommendation of renaming "Cedarpark Drive" in Plan 33M-580 to Guiness Way.

On October 6, 2011 Council resolved that the following actions be taken;

 that within three months of registration of Plan 33M-640, the City will initiate a street renaming application to change the north east portion of Cedarpark Drive, in Plan 33M-580, to Guiness Way, at no cost to the Owner.

Public and Agency Consultation

No direct circulation to individual properties was required because no properties are addressed off this section of roadway. A notice of public hearing was advertised in the London Free Press on March 24 and March 31, 2012. No responses to the circulation have been received to date.


CONCLUSION

By-law No. S .-

A by-law to rename Cedarpark Drive to Guiness Way in the City of London.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London finds it expedient to rename Cedarpark Drive to Guiness Way in the City of London.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. That the portion of Cedarpark Drive, lying west of Cedarhollow Boulevard, to Guiness Way, more particularly described as follows, shall hereafter be called and known as Guiness Way and the name of the said street is hereby changed accordingly:

"That part of Cedarpark Drive laying west of Cedarhollow Boulevard on Registered Plan 33M-580 in the City of London and County of Middlesex."

This by-law comes into force on May 1, 2012
