#### 2015-19 STRATEGIC PLAN

The following report supports the Strategic Plan through the strategic focus area of *Strengthening Our Community* by improving safety, traffic operations and residential parking needs in London's neighbourhoods.

### **BACKGROUND**

At its July 18, 2016 meeting the Civic Works Committee received a report recommending changes to the Traffic and Parking By-law to address annual safety issues during the Western Fair as outlined below:

It is recommended that By-law No. PS-111-16155 be repealed and the attached proposed by-law be introduced at Council on August 30, 2016 to implement the corrected parking regulation changes before the Western Fair begins.

# APPENDIX A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC & PARKING BY-LAW (P.S. 111) TO ADDRESS SAFETY ISSUES DURING THE WESTERN FAIR

By-law No. PS-111

A by-law to amend By-law PS-111 entitled, "A by-law to regulate traffic and the parking of motor vehicles in the City of London."

WHEREAS subsection 10(2) paragraph 7. of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws to provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable to the public;

AND WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

### 1. No Parking

Schedule "2" (No Parking) of the said By-law PS-111is hereby amended by adding the following rows:
