Dear Ms. Saunders,

This letter is with regards to the London Brewing Co-operatives Inc. Manufacturer's Limited Liquor Sales Licence Application. The London Brewing Co-operative was established in London's Old East Village November 2013 and served its first draught beer at the Root Cellar Organic Café in September 2014. With the support of our customers and the local community we are expanding to a new location at 521 Burbrook Place. This expansion will allow us to create more locally-sourced and locally hand-crafted beer while operating a retail shop for bottle sales and a tap room for tastings. Following a successful zoning variance approval by the Committee of Adjustment our new site is now able to accommodate all these uses.

As part of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario application for a tasting room, or in the parlance of the AGCO a "By the Glass" Liquor License, we require a resolution of council that demonstrates community and city support for this venture. We believe that our brewery expansion into this area and our focus on local ingredients and community engagement aligns perfectly with Principle 3 of the McCormick Area Secondary Plan that calls for "artisanal production, in the form of smallscale businesses that both manufacture and sell products on site."

To demonstrate that we have the support of the city for our AGCO application we request that Council pass the following resolution at their earliest convenience:

"Be it resolved that the City of London supports the London Brewing Co-operative, producers of a truly-local craft beer, in their application for a Manufacturer's Limited Liquor Sales Licence from the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario, for the purpose of serving beer for consumption by patrons at its manufacturing site."

Please let us know if this resolution can be included on the agenda for the July 26, 2016 meeting.
