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NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THE OFFICIAL PLAN & ZONING BY-LAW

The Municipal Council for the City of London is considering an amendment to the City's Official Plan and Zoning By-law Z.-1 for the lands shown on the attached map. The requested change is described below. We are advising you of this application to invite your comments.

APPLICANT:

City of London

LOCATION:

1577 and 1687 Wilton Grove Road - see attached map

PURPOSE AND EFFECT:

The purpose and effect of the requested Official Plan amendment and Zoning By-law amendment is to permit the development of a range of light industrial uses on the subject lands.

POSSIBLE AMENDMENT:

Change Official Plan land use designation on Schedule "A" from "Urban Reserve – Industrial Growth", "Open Space" and "Environmental Review" to "Light Industrial" and "Open Space" and add a site-specific "Special Policy" under Chapter 10 – Policies for Specific Areas, to permit an expanded range of uses including Food and Beverage Processing Industries. The application also proposes to amend Schedule B-1 of the Official Plan to revise the boundary of the Tenant's Pond Environmentally Significant Area in accordance with an Environmental Impact Study.

Change Zoning By-law Z.-1 from an Agricultural (AG2) Zone which permits a range of agricultural and agriculturally related uses, a Holding Agricultural (h-2•AG2) Zone which permits the same range of uses with a holding provision which requires an Environmental Impact Study prior to development, an Environmental Review (ER) Zone which permits a limited range of uses related to conservation, forestry and passive recreation and an Open Space (OS5) Zone which permits a limited range of uses related to conservation, forestry and passive recreation, to a Light Industrial Special Provision (LI1/LI2/LI6(_)) Zone to permit a range of light industrial uses including food and beverage processing facilities and an Open Space (OS5) Zone to restrict land uses to conservation, forestry and passive recreational uses. The City may consider the use of holding provisions to ensure the orderly development of the subject lands.

If a person or public body does not make oral or written submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City of London before the proposed amendment is adopted, the person or public body may not be entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the City of London to the Ontario Municipal Board, or may not be added by the Board as a party to the hearing of an appeal unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
