Dear Ms. Saunders:

Fanshawe College supports the City of London's proposal to amend the public nuisance by-law as described in the March 28 recommendation. We believe these amendments – giving law enforcement officials more authority to respond to nuisance parties in the city – can play an important role in addressing disruptive behaviour on private property; of particular interest to Fanshawe College is the Fleming Drive area.

We see the amendment to the by-law as an informed next step. In the past, Fanshawe has worked with the City of London and other partners to support new by-laws related to noise, rental housing licensing, the five-bedroom rule, and other issues. We are eager to continue exploring longer-term, systemic changes that will address and, ideally, prevent disruptive behaviour in neighbourhoods around the College.

Thank you for this opportunity to contribute to an important public debate. Fanshawe College will remain an active partner in this process and will be present at the meeting on April 2.
