RECOMMENDATION

That, on the recommendation of the Manager Director, Corporate Services and City Treasurer, Chief Financial Officer, the following actions **BE TAKEN** with respect to award of contract for the Delivery, Supply and Installation of Arena Dehumidification Equipment.

- (a) The tender submitted by Cimco Refrigeration, A Division of Toromont Industries LTD. 651 Wilton Grove Road, London ON N6N 1N7 at their contract price of \$149,690.00 (HST extra) **BE ACCEPTED**, it being noted that Cimco Refrigeration was the only bid received and meets the City's terms, condition and specifications.
- (b) Civic Administration **BE AUTHORIZED** to undertake all the administrative acts that are necessary in connection with these purchases; and,
- (c) Approval hereby **BE CONDITIONAL** upon the Corporation entering into formal contracts or having a purchase order, or contracts records relating to the subject matter of this approval.

BACKGROUND

PURPOSE:

This report is to seek Council approval to enter into a formal contract with Cimco Refrigeration for the supply and installation of dehumidification units at Stronach Arena and Community Center.

CONTEXT:

The City issued tenders through the Biddingo website for the supply and installation of four (4) arena specific dehumidification units to support the planned lifecycle replacement of the existing equipment at Stronach Arena and Community Center.

As only one (1) bid was received; it was considered an irregular result under Schedule A of the Procurement of Goods and Services Policy and is being reported as such.

The submission from Cimco Refrigeration was reviewed by staff from Purchasing & Supply and Facilities and meets all the City's terms, conditions and specifications.

DISCUSSION:

The existing four (4) dehumidification units are at the end of their expected lifecycle. Dehumidification units effectively and reliably control humidity and are a critical component of the artificial ice making process. These units also significantly improve the energy efficiency of the ice making process and the indoor conditions of the facility.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:

There will be an estimated future annual operating cost avoidance of \$4,000 that will assist in achieving future budget targets.

This project is eligible for an estimated rebate of \$3,000 from London Hydro that will be credited to the Energy account TS6217.
