SUBJECT:	REQUEST FOR MUNICIPAL COUNCIL SUPPORT RESOLUTION GROUND MOUNTED SOLAR PROJECT UNDER THE FEED-IN TARIFF (FIT) PROGRAM

RECOMMENDATION

That, on the recommendation of the Manager of Development Planning, the following actions be taken with respect to the application for a Category 2 FIT project to construct a ground mounted solar project at 1875 Wharncliffe Road South:

- a) the Applicant **BE ADVISED** that the Municipal Council supports the construction and operation of this project; and
- b) a Municipal Council Support Resolution in the form <u>attached</u> as Appendix "A" and "B" to this report **BE ISSUED** for this project; and
- c) the Mayor and the City Clerk **BE AUTHORIZED** to sign the Municipal Council Support Resolution noted in b) above;

it being noted that the sole purpose of this resolution is to enable the applicant to receive priority points under the Feed-in Tariff (FIT) Program and may not be used for any other form of municipal approval in relation to the project.



PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to recommend a Municipal Council support resolution for a ground mounted solar project seeking a contract under the Ontario Power Authority FIT Program Version 5.0.

BACKGROUND

The Ontario government Feed-in Tariff (FIT) Program was enacted in conjunction with the Green Energy and Green Economy Act, 2009, to facilitate the increased development of renewable generating facilities in the Province. The Province has recently announced that the window for receiving applications under the current FIT Program (Version 5.0), opens on October 31, 2016 and closes on November 18, 2016. Applications that are received during this timeframe will be evaluated by the Ontario Power Authority and awarded priority points, which are used to determine an applicant's ranking relative to other applications.

In response to the Provincial FIT Program operated by the Ontario Power Authority (OPA), staff brought forward a recommendation report to Planning and Environment Committee on July 23, 2012 to establish a process for civic administration to implement the FIT Program requirements. The recommendations were approved at the July 25th, 2012 meeting of Municipal Council, including two standardized forms prepared by staff for the purpose of Municipal Support Resolutions.


Fees for different types of FIT projects in the City of London were established by an amendment to the Planning Fees By-law CP-18, adopted by Council on January 15, 2013. Revised forms for municipal Council Support Resolutions under FIT Version 3.0 were released by the Ontario Power Authority for both Blanket Municipal Support Resolutions and individual project Municipal Support Resolutions for use by Ontario municipalities. These revised forms were presented in a report to the Planning and Environment Committee meeting on October 29th, and endorsed by Council on November 5th, 2013.

In order to receive priority points under the "Municipal Council Support" category a project must have received the support of the local municipality in which the project is located in the form of a Municipal Council Support Resolution. As noted in Table 1 below, the process requirements for FIT Category 2 Type Projects, including ground mounted solar panel installations, require a report to the Planning and Environment Committee and in some instances a site specific Municipal Support Resolution.

The *Green Energy Act, 2009, as amended*, permits renewable energy projects to be installed notwithstanding restrictions that might otherwise be imposed to prevent or restrict the activity by



local municipal by-laws (i.e. Zoning). The purpose of the Municipal Support Resolution is to enable an applicant to receive priority points that can be applied under the FIT Program evaluation criteria and the resolution does not apply to any other form of municipal approval in relation to the project. Municipal Council could refuse to endorse a Municipal Support Resolution if it is determined that the proposed facility could significantly impact adjacent land uses or municipal operations.

The only action required at this time is the endorsement of updated Municipal Council resolution forms prepared by the Province for Category 2 applications under the FIT 5.0 program.

Current Application:

An application has been received from Moose Power Inc. for a Municipal Council Resolution in support of a FIT Category 2 project. The proposal is for a 500kw ground mount solar project located on the northerly portion of a 28.3 hectare (70 acre) site on the north side of Wharncliffe Road, west of Wonderland Road South (See Site Map). Documentation submitted with the application is attached as <u>Appendix "A"</u>.

The site in question is zoned Urban Reserve (UR4), which provides for and regulates existing uses on lands which are primarily undeveloped for urban uses. There is an existing industrial / manufacturing use on site as well as a temporary golf driving range, training facility and pro shop on site.

The application was discussed internally and no significant issues were identified with respect to potential impacts on other land uses or municipal operations. Existing land uses surrounding the site include a future Commercial area to the east, Agricultural areas within the Urban Growth boundary to the north and west and existing commercial uses to the south.

The general template for Municipal Council Approval resolutions under Version 5.0 of the FIT Program, which was endorsed by Council on July 25, 2016, is attached as Appendix "A". The resolution wording specific to this project is attached as Appendix "B".

CONCLUSION	

Council is being requested to endorse a Municipal Support Resolution under the FIT Version 5.0 Program for a ground mounted solar project at 1875 Wharncliffe Road South. The project is considered to be appropriate for the proposed location, and is not expected to have any significant impact on surrounding land uses or municipal operations. This endorsement will provide the applicant with priority points to be considered in the evaluation of FIT applications by the Ontario Power Authority but is not relevant to any other form of municipal approval in relation to the application.
