- (b) The financing for this project **BE APPROVED** as set out in the Sources of Financing Report attached hereto as Appendix "A";
- (c) The Civic Administration **BE AUTHORIZED** to undertake all the administrative acts which are necessary in connection with this project;
- (d) The approval given herein **BE CONDITIONAL** upon the Corporation entering into a formal contract with the contractor for the work; and
- (e) That future additional annual operating costs of \$5,000 **BE APPROVED** as a first priority from available assessment growth in 2013 subject to final budget approval.

## **BACKGROUND**

## Purpose:

This report is submitted to seek Council approval to enter into a formal contract with Norlon Builders London Limited for the Westminster Outdoor Pool and Bathhouse Upgrades.

### Context:

Outdoor pool condition studies were completed in 2000 and updated in 2006. To support the continued delivery of seasonal aquatic programming and leisure activities throughout the City the updated study recommended the replacement of the main pool, the diving well and filter system as well as bathhouse upgrades at Westminster Pool.

#### Discussion:

The proposed renovations incorporate life cycle renewal works to the outdoor pool and bathhouse. The scope of work includes:

- Demolition of the existing main pool, diving well and wading pool.
- Construction of a new 25 meter pool with a deep end diving section.
- A zero entry access/water-play area feature with a gradual slope connecting it to the 25 meter pool.
- Replacement of existing concrete decks and pool fencing.
- The installation of a new pool heater.
- A new filtration system to meet the regulatory requirements of authorities with jurisdiction over the construction and operation of public swimming pools.
- Life cycle renewal work and accessibility upgrades to the existing bathhouse.

Tenders for the Westminster Pool & Bathhouse Upgrades were received March 8, 2012. The bid submitted by Norlon Builders London Limited was the lowest of six bids received and meets the City's specification and requirements in all areas. A summary of bids received is attached as Appendix "B".

The bid submitted by Norlon Builders London Limited offers the best value to the City and it is recommended that they be awarded a contract for the work in accordance with Section 13 of the Procurement of Goods and Services Policy.

## Impact on Annualized Operating Costs:

Additional annual operating expenses of \$5,000 for the new pool water heater system are anticipated for the Finance Department in 2013 and subsequent years with the approval of this project.
