- We Provide both Property Management and Social Supports

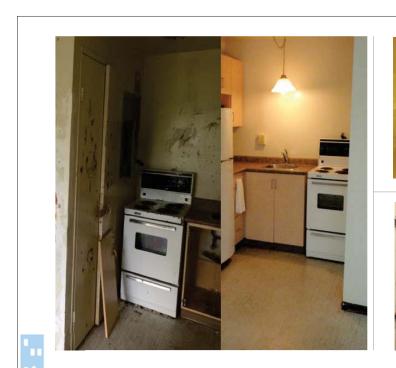

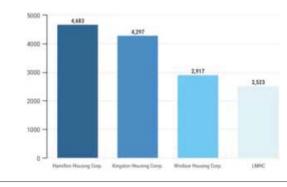






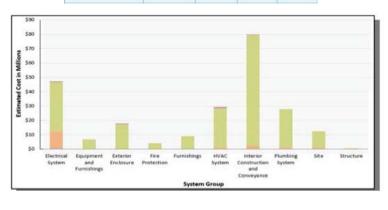


# OPERATING INVESTMENT PER UNIT



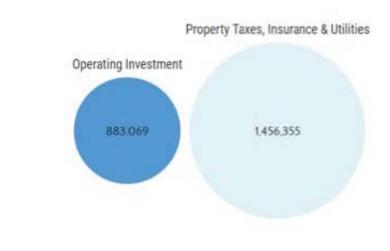
