By-law No. CPOL.-\_\_\_\_\_

A by-law to revoke and repeal Council policy related to Benefits for Common Law Spouses.

WHEREAS section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, C.25, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, C.25, as amended, provides a municipality with the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of London wishes to revoke Council policy pertaining to Benefits for Common Law Spouses;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. Any policy of The Corporation of the City of London approved, adopted, or amended by Municipal Council on a day prior to the day this by-law is in force and effect, pertaining to Benefits for Common Law Spouses is hereby revoked.
2. Any by-law of The Corporation of the City of London in force and effect on a day prior to the day this by-law is in force and effect, which approves, amends or adopts a Council policy pertaining to Benefits for Common Law Spouses is hereby repealed.
3. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the date it is passed.
