By-law No. A.-

A By-law to approve the Funding Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada, as represented by the Federal Minister of Human Resources and Skills Development for funding under the Homelessness Partnering Strategy; and to authorize the Mayor and the City Clerk to execute the Agreement.

WHEREAS section 2 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that municipalities are created by the Province of Ontario to be responsible and accountable governments with respect to matters within their jurisdiction and each municipality is given powers and duties under this Act and many other Acts for the purpose of providing good government with respect to those matters;

AND WHEREAS section 3.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* states that the Province acknowledges that a municipality has the authority to enter into agreements with the Crown in Right of Canada with respect to matters within the municipality's jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS section 10 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that the City may provide any service or thing that the City considers necessary or desirable for the public, and may pass by-laws respecting same, and respecting economic, social and environmental well-being of the City, and the health, safety and well-being of persons;

AND WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. The Funding Agreement to be entered into between The Corporation of the City of London and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada, as represented by the Federal Minister of Human Resources and Skills Development, for funding under the Homelessness Partnering Strategy (HPS), is hereby approved.
2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are authorized to execute the agreement approved under section 1 above substantially in the form attached as Schedule 1 to this By-law and to the satisfaction of the City Solicitor.
3. The City of London's Executive Director of Community Services, or written designate, is delegated signing authority regarding budgets, cash flows, other financial reporting including financial claims under section 8 of Schedule B, and directions, consents and other authorizations as may be required in order to permit auditors to discuss its reports with representatives of Canada and provide any requested information to them in relation to the audit under section 10.1, pursuant to the agreement approved under section 1 above, provided that the monetary amounts do not exceed the maximum amount of Canada's contribution specified in the agreement.
4. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the day it is passed.
