Monthly Report for February 2012

Attached are the Building Division's monthly report for February 2012 and copies of the Summary of the Inspectors' Workload reports.

Permit Issuance

By the end of February, 492 permits had been issued with a construction value of approximately \$64.1 million dollars, representing 147 new dwelling units. Compared to last year, this represents a 17.4% increase in the number of permits, a 51.2% decrease in the construction value and a 26.9% decrease in the number of dwelling units.

To the end of February, the number of single and semi detached dwellings issued were 106, which was a 14.0% increase over last year.

At the end of February, there were 397 applications in process, representing approximately 191 million dollars in construction value and an additional 626 dwelling units, compared with 246 applications having a construction value of 191 million dollars and an additional 395 dwelling units for the same period last year.

The rate of incoming applications for the month of February averaged out to 13.1 applications a day for a total of 261 in 20 working days. There were 46 permit applications to build 46 new single detached dwellings.

There were 225 permits issued in February totalling \$26,854,615 including 56 new dwelling units.

Analysis of the issue dates show that for the month of February all types of permits, 5% were issued within 1 week, 12% were issued within 2 weeks and 35% were issued within 3 weeks. The report indicates that for single and semi detached dwellings, 6% were issued within 1 week, 14% were issued within 2 weeks, 20% within 12 days, 37% were issued within 4 weeks.

Inspections

Due to the Amanda reporting on scheduling inspections which inflates the numbers, only one inspection call per permit is counted, and only one inspection completed per permit is recorded.

Building Inspectors received 906 inspection calls and conducted 1,356 building permit related inspections with an additional 41 inspections completed relating to complaints, licenses, orders and miscellaneous inspections. This is a total of 1,397 inspections or an average of 140 inspections made per inspector this month based on 10 inspectors, which averages out to 8.2 inspections per day per inspector. (Note: 200 person working days – 29 vac/sick day/training = 171. There are a total of 9,326 active building permits or an average of 932 permits per inspector. The provincially mandated requirement to inspect within 48 hours of receipt of an inspection request was achieved 100% of the time.

Plumbing Inspectors received 495 inspection calls and conducted a total of 759 permit related inspections, there were 28 inspections performed that related to the Backflow Prevention Program. Inspections relating to complaints, orders and miscellaneous calls totalled a further 2 inspections. During the month a total of 789 inspections were conducted with an average of 158 per inspector, which averages out to 8.9 inspections per day per inspector. (Note: 100 person working days — 11 vac/sick day/training = 89). Active building permits involving plumbing totalled 3,207 or 641 on average per inspector. The provincially mandated requirement to inspect within 48 hours of receipt of an inspection request was achieved 99% of the time.

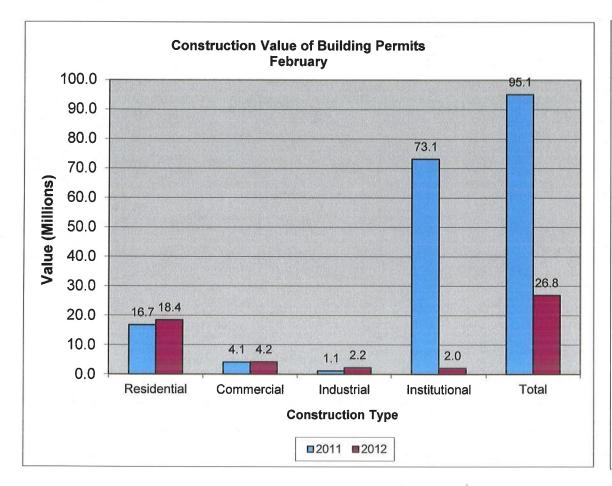

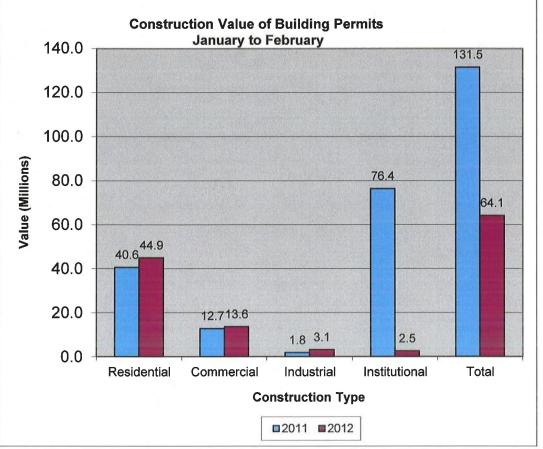
