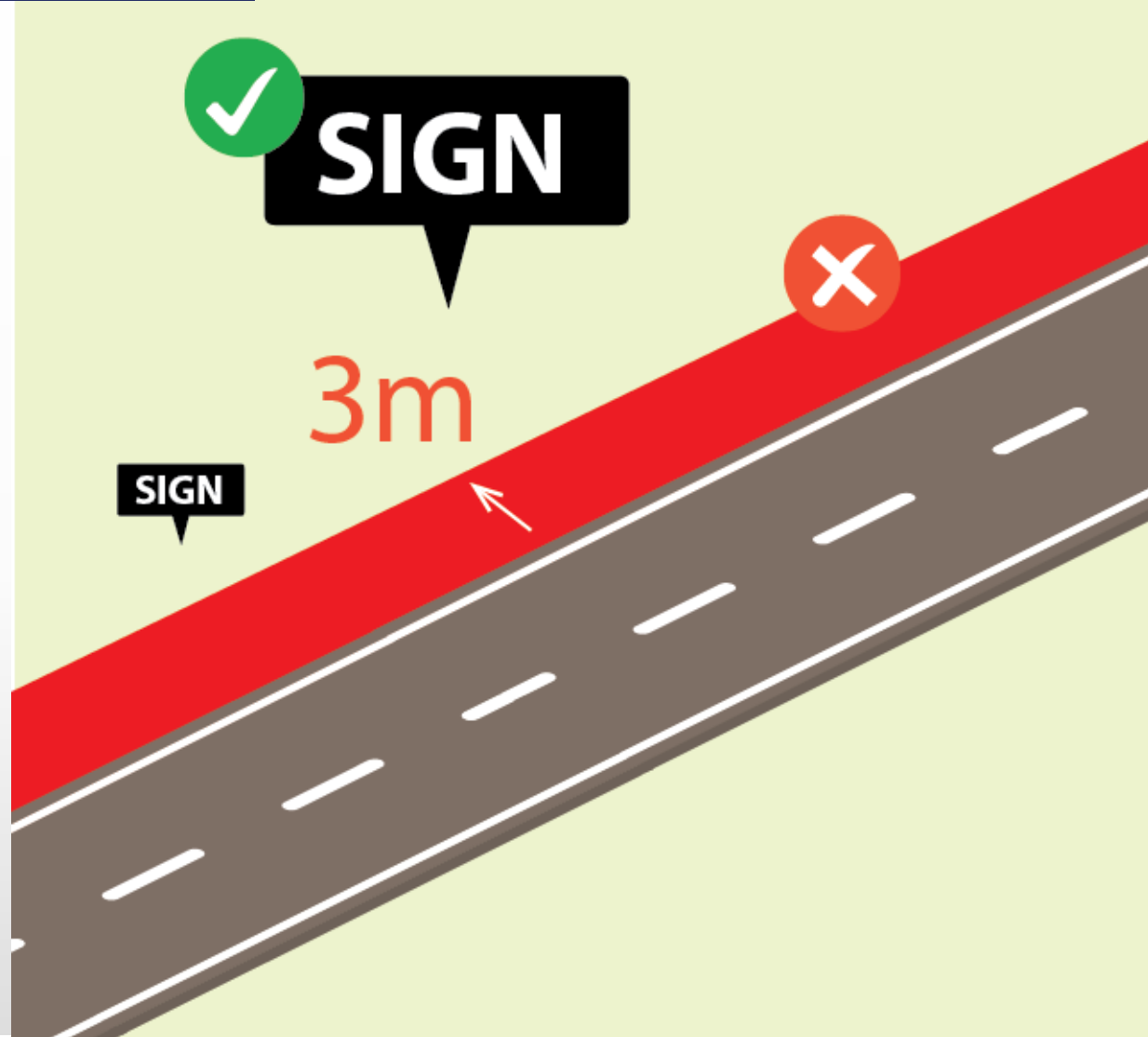

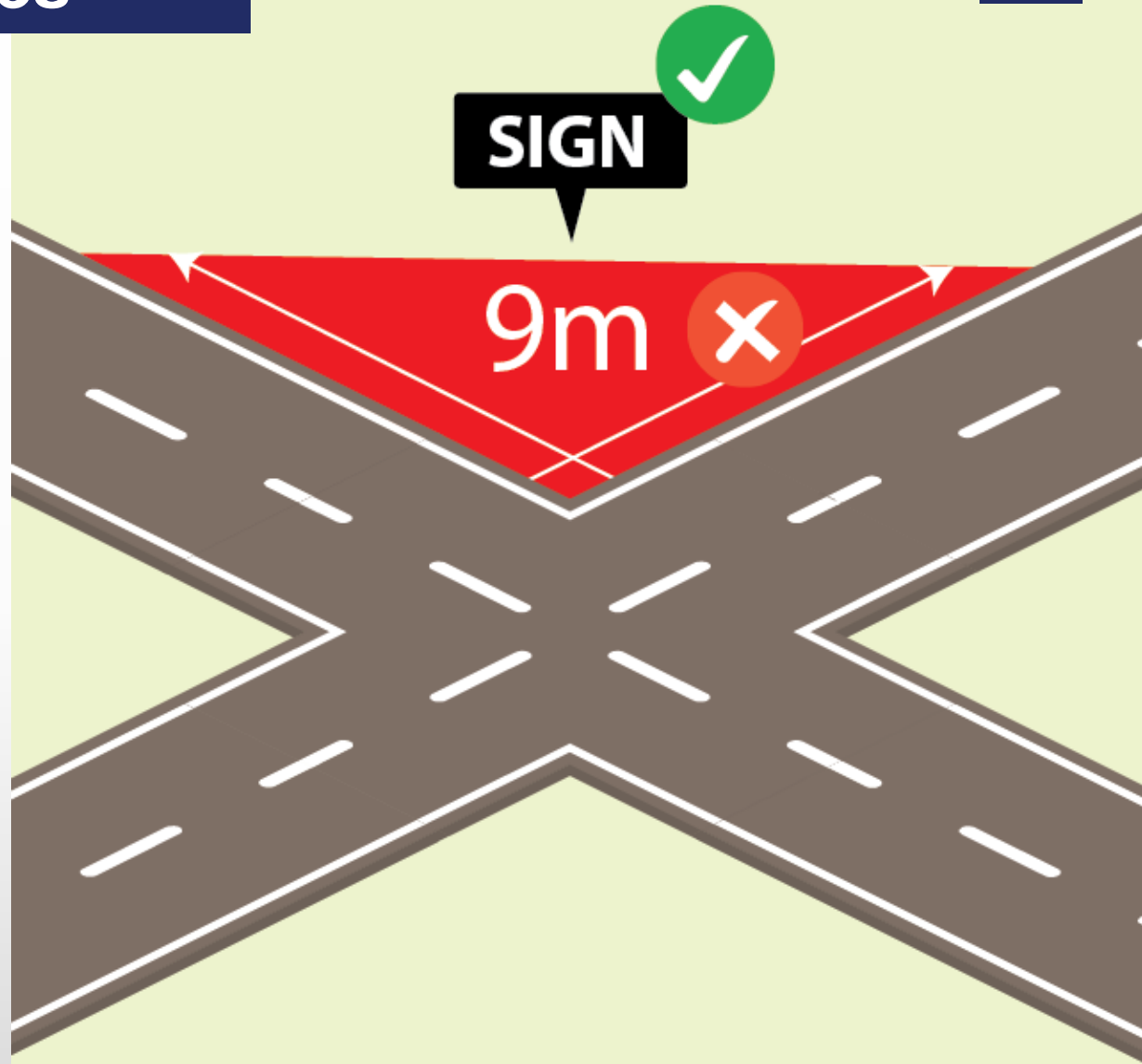
Edge of Road *Section: 4.4(b)*

Election signs have to be a minimum of 3 metres from the edge of the roadway.



Site Triangle *Section: 4.3(e)*

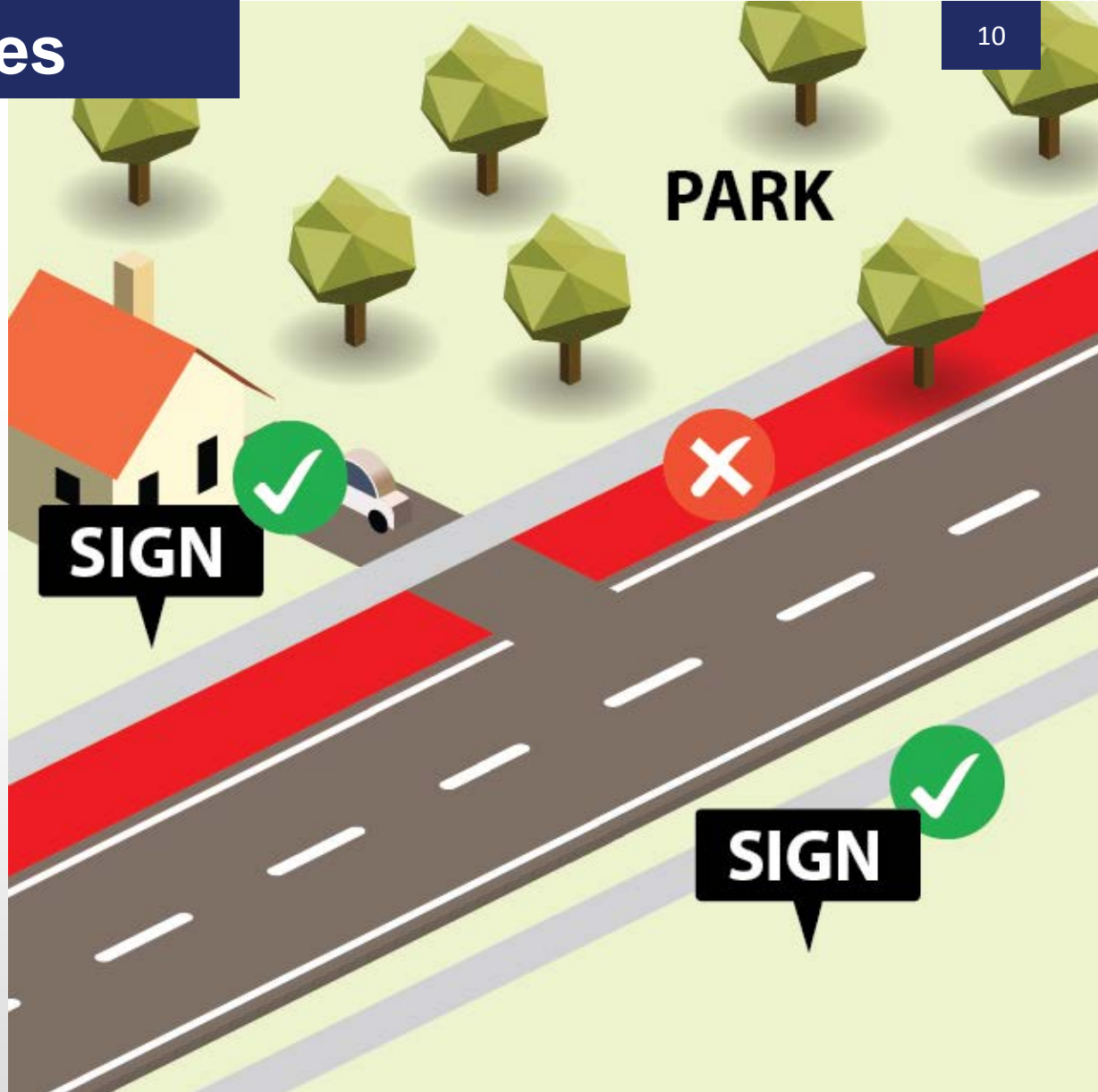
Election signs are prohibited within a sight triangle at the intersection of two roadways



Beside a Park

Section: 4.3(g)

Election signs are prohibited in a boulevard beside a park.

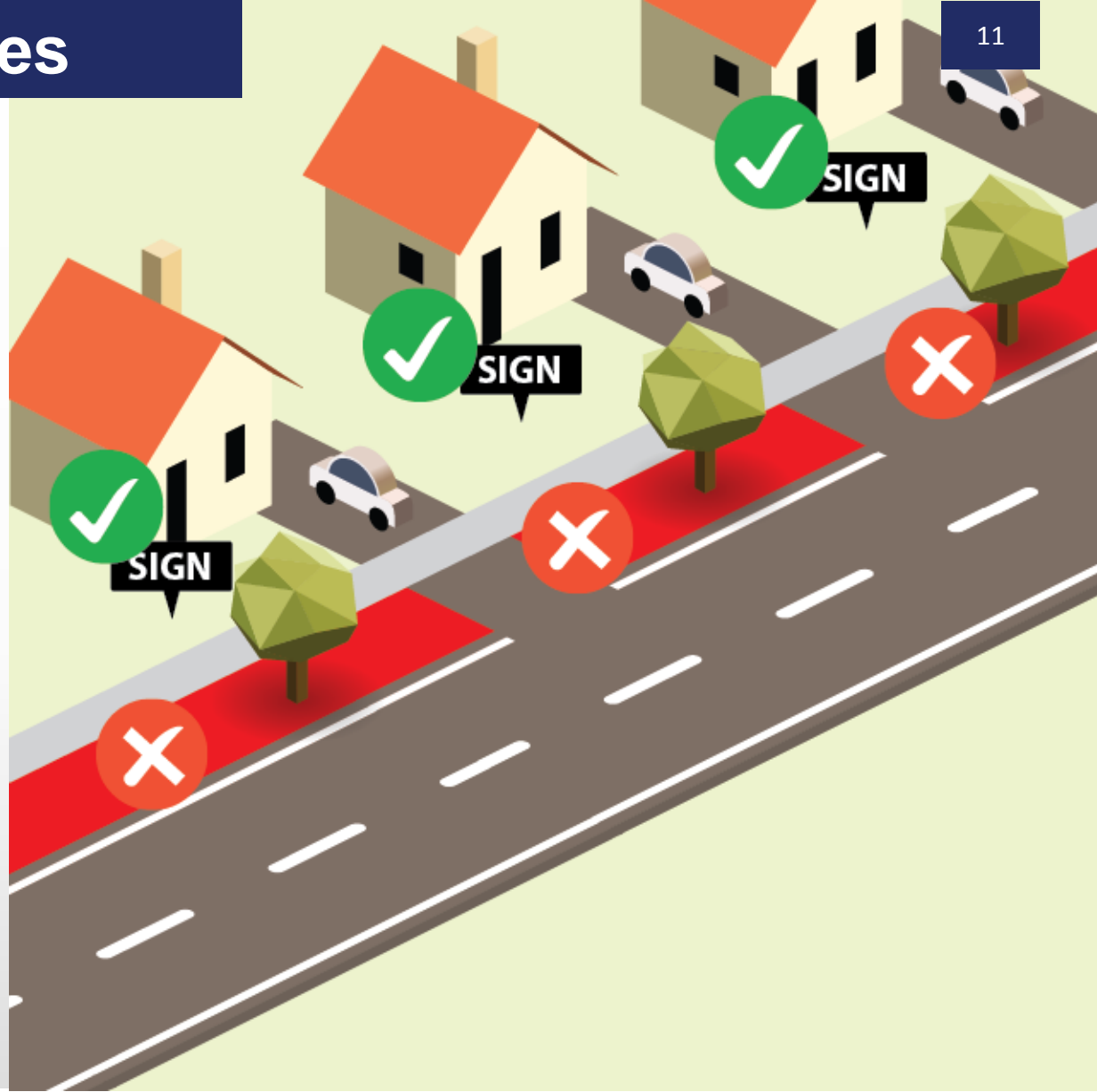


Road Allowances

Between the Sidewalk & Road

Section: 4.3(c)

Election signs are not permitted between the sidewalk and the roadway.

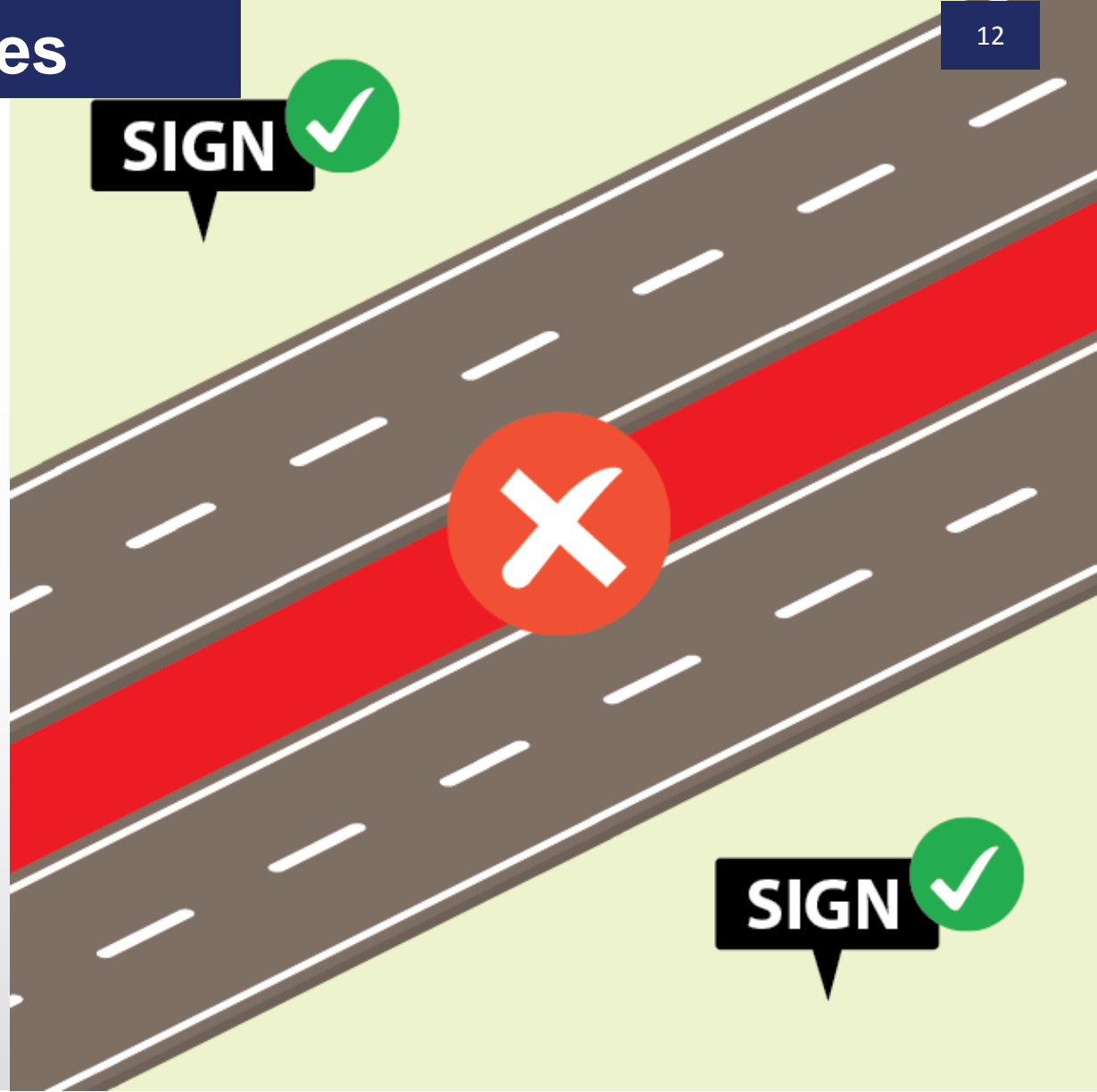


Road Allowances

On or Over a Road or Sidewalk

Section: 4.3(a)(b)

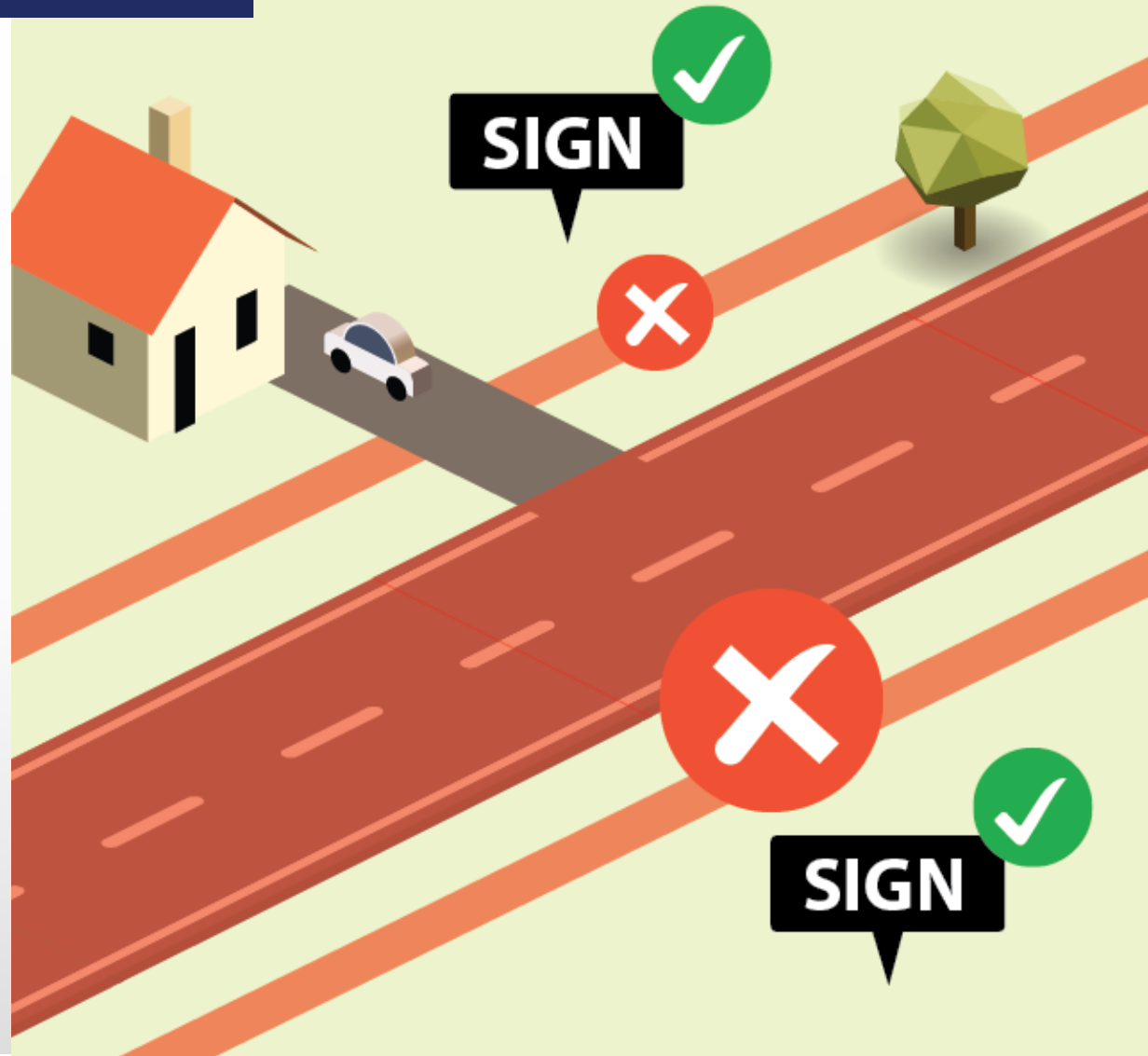
Election signs are prohibited on or over a roadway or sidewalk.



Between Two Roads

Section: 4.3(d)

Election signs are prohibited on the portion of the road allowance between each roadway.



Signs

Attached to...

Sections: 4.3(h)(i), 4.6, 4.7

Election signs may not be attached to utility poles or box, light poles, trees, bus shelters, planters, benches, waste receptacles, newspaper or mail boxes, etc.



Public Parks and Property

Public Park & Property

Section: 4(1)(2)

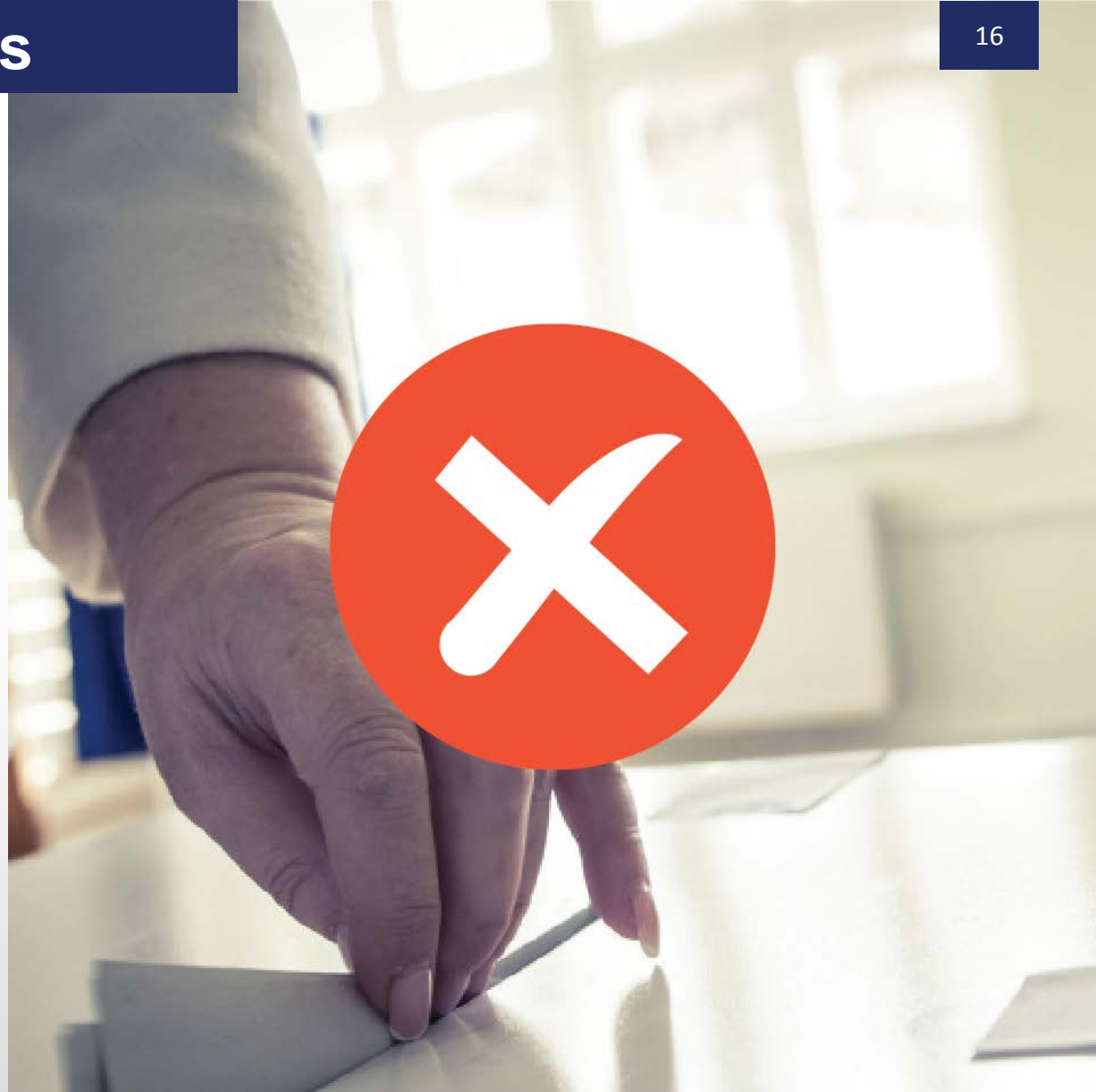
Election signs are not permitted in any public parks or on property owned or occupied by the City of London or any local board.



Polling Locations

Section: 2.4

Election signs are not permitted on any premises used as a polling place for elections. In the case of schools, libraries and shopping malls, the entire property is considered a polling place.
