#### Purpose of Report

This report covers the period from January to December, 2016, and provides insight into the statistics of the 1195 Syrian Government-Assisted Refugees who arrived over the course of the calendar year. It represents the information in both a graphic and table format.

#### Report Structure

This report is divided in three sections:

General Statistics – this section tracks the number of refugees who came from each country of origin, as well as the number of families who came each month and the corresponding number of families who were moved out.

Demographic Profile – this section tracks information about age, gender, family size, marital status, family relationships and education level.

Professional Profile – this section tracks information about the professional qualifications of the adult population along seven areas of economic activity: services, trades, technology, public, entrepreneurs, education, and farming.


#### Method





#### Distribution of Total Population by Gender





# Distribution of Total Population by Adults and Children





#### Distribution of Children Aged 6 and Under by Yearly Age Groups





#### Distribution of Adult and Child Populations by Gender






#### Distribution of Adult Population by Marital Status

### Distribution of Total Population by Family Relationship







#### Distribution of Total Population by Education Level










