Bill No. 104 2017 By-law No. S.-____

A by-law to change the name of Cedarpark Crescent lying east of Cedarhollow Boulevard to Cedarpark Way, in the City of London, and to repeal By-law No. S.-5830-3 entitled, "A by-law to change the name of Cedarpark Crescent lying east of Cedarhollow Boulevard to Cedarpark Way, in the City of London".

WHEREAS the Municipal Council enacted By-law No. S.-5830-3 on December 6, 2016 to change the name of Cedarpark Crescent lying east of Cedarhollow Boulevard to Cedarpark Way, in the City of London;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to repeal By-law No. S.-5830-3 due to a clerical error in the legal description of the lands;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London deems it expedient to rename the portion of Cedarpark Crescent lying east of Cedarhollow Boulevard, in the City of London to Cedarpark Way;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. That Cedarpark Crescent lying east of Cedarhollow Boulevard shall hereinafter be called and known as Cedarpark Way, and the name of the said street is hereby changed accordingly:

"All of Cedarpark Crescent abutting Lot 32 on Plan 33M-580, in the City of London and County of Middlesex;

and

Block 148 on Plan 33M-580, in the City of London and County of Middlesex;

and

Cedarpark Crescent on Plan 33M-640 save and except Part 1 on 33R-19563, in the City of London and County of Middlesex."

- 2. By-law No. S.-5830-3 passed by Municipal Council on December 6, 2016 entitled, "A by-law to change the name of Cedarpark Crescent lying east of Cedarhollow Boulevard to Cedarpark Way, in the City of London", is hereby repealed.
- 3. This By-law comes into force and effect on the day it is passed.
