I went to the meeting knowing somewhat about floridation, but came out being very educated. I heard the concern on both sides, and realized that although floridation of water does assist in prevention of dental disease, there is no way to control the amount of floridation a person can inject in a day due to no control over the dosage.

Due to the inability to measure the intake of floride for the people injecting water in the city of London, I ask that floride be removed from our water to ensure our safety.
