A by-law to amend By-law A-39 entitled, "A By-law respecting the Civic Administration" to change the titles of "Chief Administrative Officer" and Deputy Chief Administrative Officer" to "City Manager" and "Deputy City Manager", respectively.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of London wishes to amend By-law A-39 entitled "A By-law respecting the Civic Administration";

AND WHEREAS section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

- 1. The Civic Administration By-law, being By-law No. A-39, is hereby amended as follows:
 - (i) by deleting the words "the Chief and Deputy Chief Administrative Officer" contained in part (a) of section 1 and by replacing them with the words "the City Manager and Deputy City Manager";
 - (ii) by deleting the table contained in section 3 in its entirety and by replacing it with the following new table:

- (iii) by deleting the term "Chief Administrative Officer" contained throughout the bylaw and by replacing it with the term "City Manager"; and
- (iv) by deleting the term "Deputy Chief Administrative Officer" contained throughout the by-law and by replacing it with the term "Deputy City Manager".
- 2. This by-law comes into force and effect on October 3, 2011.
