The City of London is completing the design for Kiwanis Park Recreational Pathway Connection and CNR Crossing project which will begin construction in spring of 2017, pending Council approval. This letter provides you with information about the project and the upcoming public meeting.

**Location:** Kiwanis Park, South of Trafalgar Street. Across CNR tracks to pathway connection East of Laurentian Dr S.

**Schedule:** Tentative Start – Spring 2017  
Tentative Timeline – Spring 2017 to Spring 2018

**Scope:** This construction project will include new pathways (including bridges over Pottersburg Creek and a boardwalk over low lying area) connecting Northerly and Southerly portions of Kiwanis Park - Central South and a Pedestrian Bridge over CNR tracks.

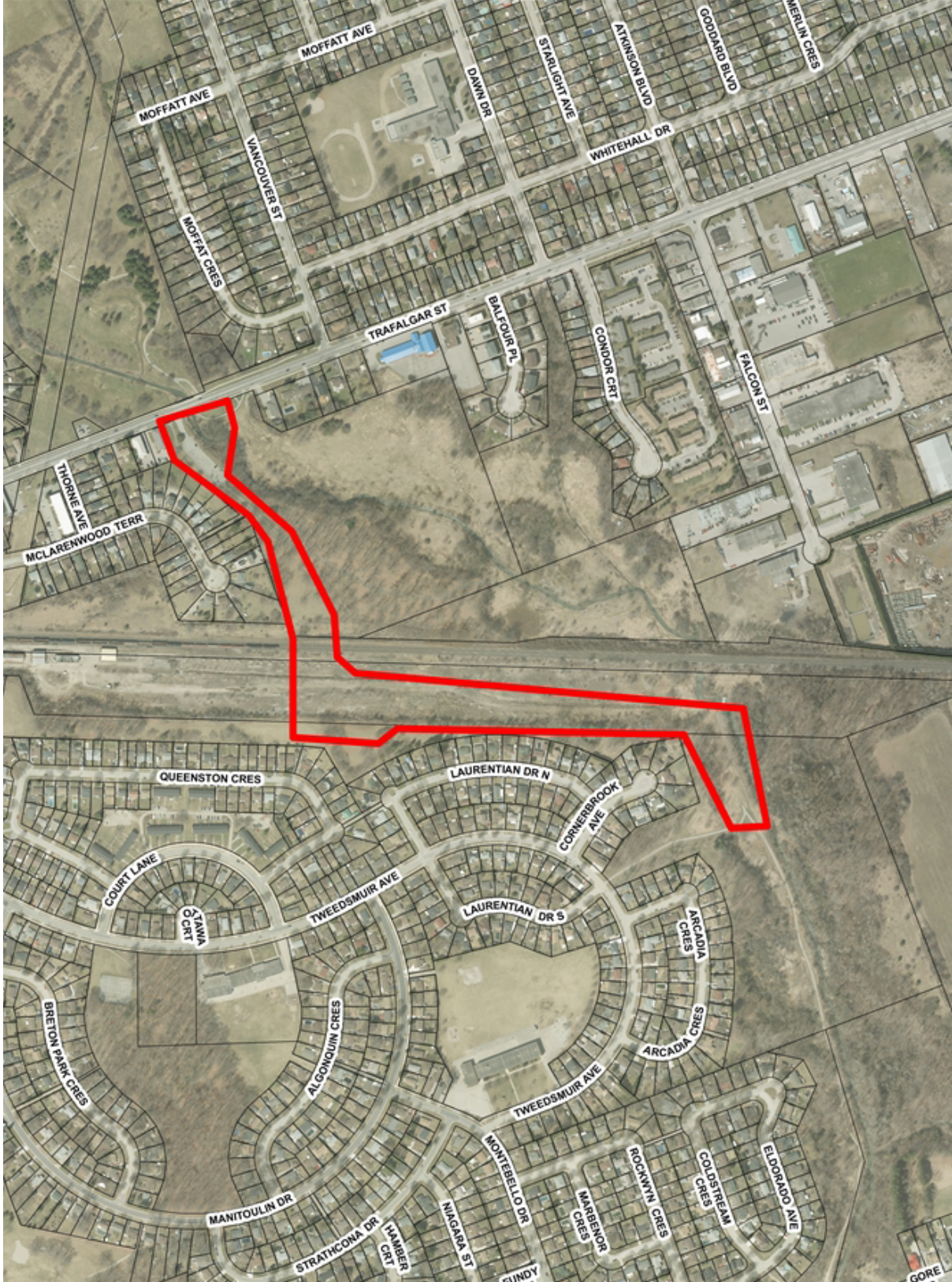
