

PART 1: Draw Your Streetscape

Example Streetscape Drawing






PART 2: Streetscape Character

Step 2: Tally up the total number of properties that fit into each characteristic. Write the sum under the TOTAL column.


A. Front Yard Condition


B. Building Height

- C.3 6 or more steps above grade




D. Garage Location


E. Porches and Stoops
