I am pleased to be writing to invite you to participate in an initiative of the Accessibility Advisory Committee (ACCAC) of the City of London that will help shape and define the Multi-Year Accessibility Plan starting in 2018. - d) This process will be repeated twice to allow participants share their views on more than one topic. Again, this will be contingent upon the number of participants attending.
- e) At this point, participants will be invited to rate the jotted ideas in order to determine the most relevant from the lists. 20 minutes will be allotted to this.
- f) Finally, we will wrap up the open house by highlighting the ideas and suggestions that participants found to be most relevant.
- g) In total the open house event will be 2.5 hours long.
