Dear Mayor Brown and Members of City Council,

I write on behalf of the students, faculty, and staff of King's University College regarding the proposed Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) routing on north Richmond. This initiative will define how the next generation of Londoners move about our city. Students make up a significant portion of those Londoners who regularly utilize public transportation and King's is grateful to see that their concerns are being given a high priority in the planning of the BRT.

King's realizes that you must consider many important factors and we appreciate your willingness to listen to our concerns related to the routing of the BRT through the north Richmond corridor. We believe the route running North on Richmond and then through the Richmond gates at Western will best serve the approximately 4,000 students of King's by providing near-campus access. This route will alleviate some of the potential congestion on the residential streets around King's campus related to student driven vehicles that may result if an alternate route was selected that by-passed our campus.

Thank you again for your attention to these issues and we look forward to continued mutual support and cooperation between King's and the City of London.
