I'm a Londoner and I support moving forward with a strong rapid transit system.

I don't drive, and I think a city the size of this one should allow me to get around without a car. There are non-drivers of all ages, incomes, shapes, colours, sizes, and needs - we need to support them in getting where they want to go. And getting around without adding significantly to greenhouse gases, traffic congestion or road wear. (Honestly, we're doing lots of people a big favour.)

Yes, there will be some short-term pain. But it's the right plan. Please support BRT in our wonderful city!
