- 3) The additional funding requirement of \$856,210 is available as a transfer of Federal Gas Tax from PD2135-14 and PD2135-12 primarily allocated for the Thames Valley Pathway North Branch project.
- 4) Development Charges have been utilized in accordance with the underlying legislation and the Development Charges Background Study completed in 2014.

- 5) Administration hereby certifies that the estimated amounts payable in respect of this project does not exceed the annual financial debt and obligation limit for the Municipality of Municipal Affairs in accordance with the provisions of Ontario Regulation 403/02 made under the Municipal Act, and accordingly the City Clerk is hereby requested to prepare and introduce the necessary authorizing by-law.
 - An authorizing by-law should be drafted to secure debenture financing for project PD2159 Kiwanis Park Pathway Connection (PTIF) for the net amount to be debentured of \$725,000.
- 6) There will be additional operating costs approximately in the amount of \$2,500 in the operating parks budget in 2018 and beyond for the additional park infrastructure.
