Interest reason: I'm interested in changing the role our central library plays in London. I believe it's important for us to centralize our resources in one hub, that being the London Central Library. As a city we need to bridge the gap between existing resources available to the community-at-large and the people who need them the most. Many organizations face a problem of outreach and being able to connect their resources with those that demand it. Middlesex County has turned their central library into a community hub of many organizations. It's important for us to remain relevant to Londoners by providing formats they look for. Therefore, continuing to digitizing our library resources is important. Free access too public computers and the internet is necessary to so many in our community. I also have an idea which is inspired by the natural phenomenon that exists within many newcomer families, where youth and children help their parents integrate into Canadian society. Many young people help their parents with language barriers, and computer skills. I think the library should create a program that allows for youth to teach adult newcomers English and financial literacy. The Educational Curriculum has to be thoughtfully designed by educators and staff to be user friendly and easy for a young person to use. Classes can run for 90 minutes over one 12-week semester, focusing on either conversational English or the basics of computer skills. Youth will go over learning objectives with their adult participant and will go through lessons at the pace of the adult, honoring their learning goals. Each adults and youth are provided with a binder with all lessons pre-organized by Staff, along with checklists to measure the progress of the adult. Overall, i'm interested in bringing innovative new ideas to help our Library be more

accessible, friendly and a community hub.
