SUBJECT:	AMENDMENTS TO THE TRAFFIC AND PARKING BY-LAW

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

That on the recommendation of the Managing Director, Environmental & Engineering Services and City Engineer, the <u>attached</u> proposed by-law (Appendix A) **BE**INTRODUCED at the Municipal Council meeting to be held on June 13, 2017 for the purpose of amending the Traffic and Parking By-law (PS-113).

## 2015-19 STRATEGIC PLAN

The following report supports the Strategic Plan through the strategic focus area of **Strengthening Our Community** by improving safety, traffic operations and residential parking needs in London's neighbourhoods.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Traffic and Parking By-law (PS-113) requires amendments (Appendix A) to address traffic safety, operations and parking concerns. The following amendments are proposed:

## 1. No Stopping

Staff received a request from By-law Enforcement and the London Police to review the operation of John Street from Richmond Street to St. George Street, due to heavy congestion causing safety concerns between 9:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m. When vehicles are stopping to unload or load passengers, they block the passage of other vehicles. It is recommended to install a 'No Stopping 9:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m.' zone on the south side of John Street from 35 m west of Richmond Street to St. George Street as shown in Figure 1. It should be noted, that John Street from 35 m west of Richmond Street to Richmond Street is wider and can accommodate vehicles for short-term loading or unloading of passengers.

An amendment is required to Schedule 1 (No Stopping) for the above change.

### 2. No Parking

Staff received a request from London Transit to review the on-street parking near transit stops on Admiral Drive and Fairview Avenue. Vehicles that park too close to the transit stop make it difficult to load passengers from the sidewalk connector pad and make it difficult for the transit bus to egress the transit stop. It is recommended to extend the 'No Parking Anytime' zones at the transit stops by 5 m to address the concerns on the north side of Admiral Court west of Bonaventure Drive and the east side of Fairview Avenue 34 m north of Fairview Court .

A review of Schedule 2 (No Parking) determined that the No Parking signs at the transit stop east of Vaubois Place on Admiral Drive were missing from the by-law.

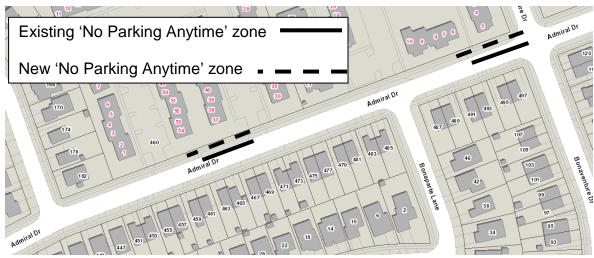


Figure 2: Admiral Drive, Vaubois Place to Bonaventure Drive

An amendment is required to Schedule 2 (No Parking) for the above changes.

### 3. Reserved Lanes

New bicycle lanes are being constructed on Byron Baseline Road on the north and south side from Grand View Avenue to North Street. Signs prohibiting parking in the bicycle lane are required to ensure the bicycle safety.

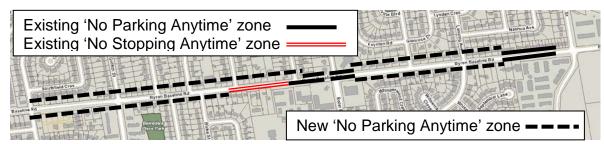


Figure 4: Byron Baseline Road from Grand View Avenue to North Street

An amendment is required to Schedule 2 (No Parking) and Schedule 9.1 (Reserved Lane) for the above changes.

## 4. Pedestrian Crossover (PXO)

A pedestrian crossing study was conducted on Dundas Street at the intersection with English Street, which concluded a Type B PXO is warranted for pedestrians crossing Dundas Street.

An amendment is required to Schedule 13.1 (Pedestrian Crossovers) for the above changes.

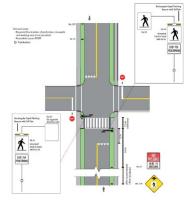


Figure 5: Type B PXO

## 5. Speed Limits

It is recommended that the speed limit be reduced to 40 km/h at the following locations as per the School Zone Speed Limit Policy approved by Council:

Old Garrison Boulevard (north intersection) to 64 m south of Old Garrison Boulevard (south intersection)

Old Garrison Boulevard Settlement Trial (north intersection) to Crane Avenue (north intersection)

Old Garrison Boulevard Settlement Trial (south intersection) to Crane Avenue (south intersection)

Settlement Trial (south intersection)

Settlement Trial Gristmill Lane to 69 m south of Old Garrison Boulevard (south intersection)

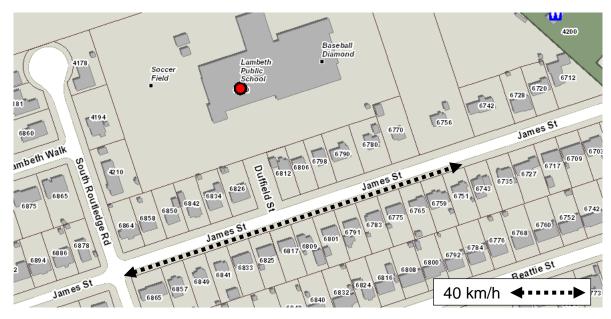


Figure 8: Lambeth Public School

# APPENDIX A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC & PARKING BY-LAW (PS-113)

Bill No.

By-law No. PS-113

A by-law to amend By-law PS-113 entitled, "A by-law to regulate traffic and the parking of motor vehicles in the City of London."

WHEREAS subsection 10(2) paragraph 7. Of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws to provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable to the public;

AND WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

## 1. No Stopping

Schedule 1 (No Stopping) of the P.S.-113 By-law is hereby amended by **adding** the following rows:
