SUBJECT:	CLOSED ADULT LIVE ENTERTAINMENT PARLOUR 2190 DUNDAS STREET EAST

RECOMMENDATION

That, on the recommendation of the Managing Director of Development and Compliance Services and Chief Building Official, this report **BE RECEIVED** for information purposes, it being noted that a public participation meeting will be required if the Community and Protective Services Committee directs that Civic Administration begin the process of deleting locations and / or reducing the number of permitted adult live entertainment parlours.

BACKGROUND

Adult live entertainment parlours are licensed under the City's Business Licensing By-law L-6. Section 3.29 of By-law L-6 states that:

Where the Licence Manager reasonably believes that during any period of six (6) consecutive calendar months no adult live entertainment has been provided in an adult live entertainment parlour in respect of which,

- (a) a licence issued under this Part of this by-law has expired or has been terminated before or during such period; and*
- (b) the licence has not been renewed or no new licence has been issued prior to the end of such period,*

the Licence Manager shall report such belief to the Community and Protective Services Committee for the purpose of the Community and Protective Services Committee giving consideration to whether or not the location of the adult live entertainment parlour should be deleted as a defined area or location mentioned in paragraph (a) of section 3.12 of this Part of this by-law.

By-law L-6 defines areas or locations designated to permit adult live entertainment parlours. The number of licences authorized by this part of this by-law for the operation of adult live entertainment parlours within the City is limited at any time to four locations. Currently there are three adult live entertainment parlours operating in London.

2190 Dundas Street East – Famous Flesh Gordons

The adult live entertainment parlour located at 2190 Dundas Street East has been operating for a number of years under the name of Famous Flesh Gordons.

In early 2015, the adult live entertainment parlour closed. At approximately the same time period, the establishment's liquor licence was suspended. A City business licence was issued for 2015.

In 2016, a business licence application was submitted by 751809 Ontario Inc. Inspections were undertaken however, a fire inspection was outstanding due to failure to confirm an inspection date. Throughout the year, discussions were held with the applicant's solicitor with respect to the business licence issuance. There was some uncertainty with the status of a new liquor licence application at

that time. In the end, no business licence was issued for 2016.

In December 2016, a new application for a adult live entertainment parlour was submitted by Paris Clubs Corporation. In January 2017, staff contacted the new applicant to schedule inspections. Staff were advised that some minor renovations would be forthcoming and that contact will be made when the renovations were complete. The applicant contacted staff in May and June 2017 indicating that renovations were ongoing.

Municipal Law Enforcement Officers (MLEO) attended the location on numerous occasions in 2017 during day and evening shifts. At no time was the establishment open to the public. On July 6, 2017, MLEOs visited the location and renovations were in progress.

Based on the above summary, the Licence Manager reasonably believes that: during any period of six (6) consecutive calendar months, no adult live entertainment has been provided at this location and no new licences have been issued. In compliance with section 3.29 of the Business Licensing by-law, Civic Administration is reporting this information to CPSC.
