By-law No. CP-7-amend

A by-law to amend By-law CP-7, entitled "A by-law to provide for the City of London and the London Consent Authority".

COMMUNITY PLANNING

WHEREAS subsection 54(45) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, provides that Municipal Council may by by-law delegate the authority of the council for the giving of consents under section 53 of the Act or any part of that authority, to an appointed officer, identified in the by-law, by name or position occupied;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. Section 2, of By-law CP-7, as amended, is hereby further amended, by repealing Section 2.2 in its entirety and replacing it with the following new section 2.2:

"2.2 Approval Authority – City Planner Absence

When the City Planner is absent or his office is vacant, then the Manager, Development Services and Planning Liaison, or when he is absent or his office is vacant, the Manager, Community Planning and Design shall act in the place and stead of the City Planner under this by-law and while so acting, the Manager, Development Services and Planning Liaison or the Manager, Community Planning and Design has and may exercise all the rights, powers, and authority of the City Planner as delegated by this by-law subject to the same responsibilities and limitations as set out in Part 2.1 of this by-law."

2. This by-law comes into force and effect on the date that it is passed.
