Who is involved in the process and what is their role?

There are a number of different groups that are involved in this process, they include:

ROLE OF LOCAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE (LAC)

- Identify and confirm ESA management issues;
- May attend ESA site visits;
- Help to develop the restoration plan, trail plan and recommendations;
- Prioritize implementation of recommendations, and;
- Review the draft Phase II CMP report

ROLE OF EEPAC AND ACCAC

- Provide review of draft Phase II CMP report based on technical skills and mandate of the Committees.

ROLE OF THE PUBLIC

- Provide community input regarding the Phase II CMP.

ROLE OF COUNCIL

- To review and approve a final CMP based on input from LAC, EEPAC, ACCAC and the community.
