# Work to Date

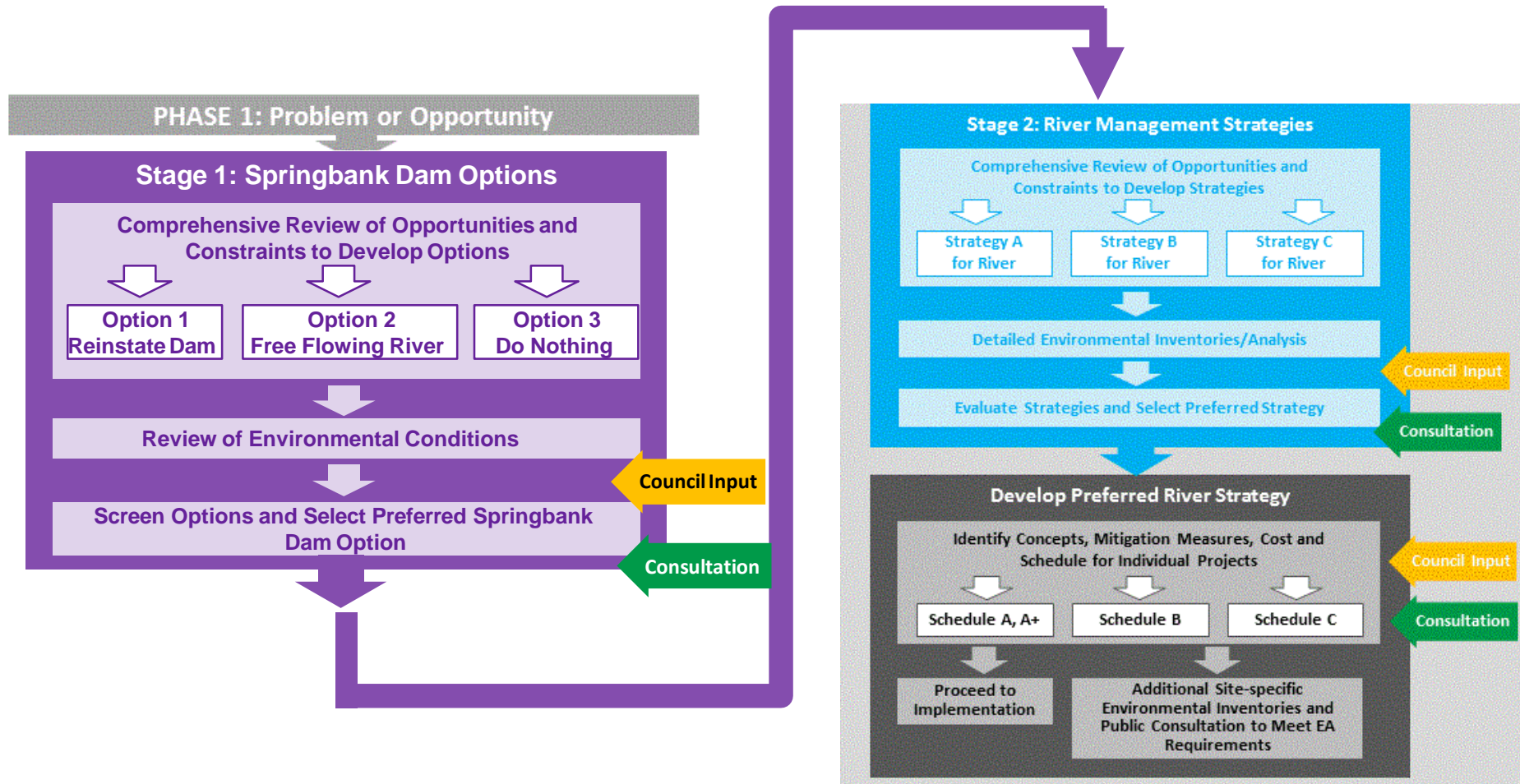
- Issued Notice of Commencement

# One River EA Process



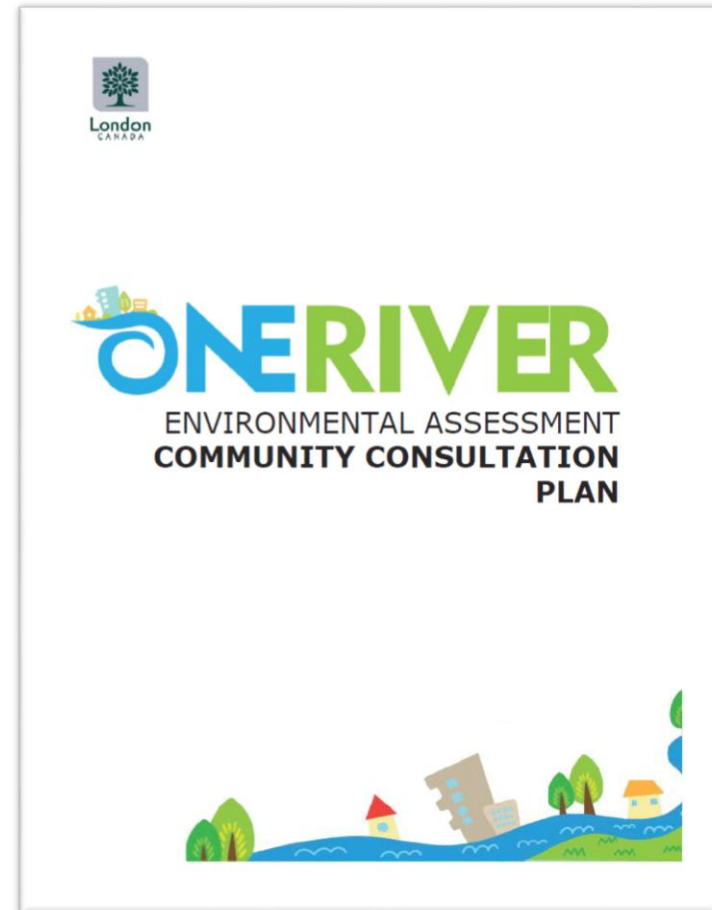
# Springbank Dam Alternatives

- Do Nothing  
Dam is left as-is
- Free-Flowing River  
Dam is decommissioned and no longer provides water retention but may be repurposed
- Reinststate the Dam  
Dam is reinstated to provide a water retention function



# Community Consultation Plan

- Make the community aware of the One River Master Plan EA and encourage involvement
- Provide opportunities for the general public, stakeholder groups, and Indigenous and First Nations Communities to participate and provide feedback
- Deliver timely updates to Council
- Ensure the public and Council are well-informed with accurate data and information



# Consultation Approach



## Pre-Consultation & Project Launch

Following the release of the Notice of Commencement, but prior to PICs a series of pop-up events will be held to increase visibility of the study, understand initial sentiment and participation data, and build contact lists.



## Reports to Civic Works Committee and Council

Technical work plans, initial findings from permitting agencies, stances of stakeholders, and general public sentiment will be presented to the Civic Works Committee and Council. Decisions and guidance from the Civic Works Committee and Council will guide the materials and direction of future PIC events.



## Public Information Centres

Held to provide updates and presentations, which will give the public the opportunity to learn about the progress of the study and to provide input.



## Completion of EA

Following the development of the Draft Master Plan, it will be made available for review as per EA requirements.





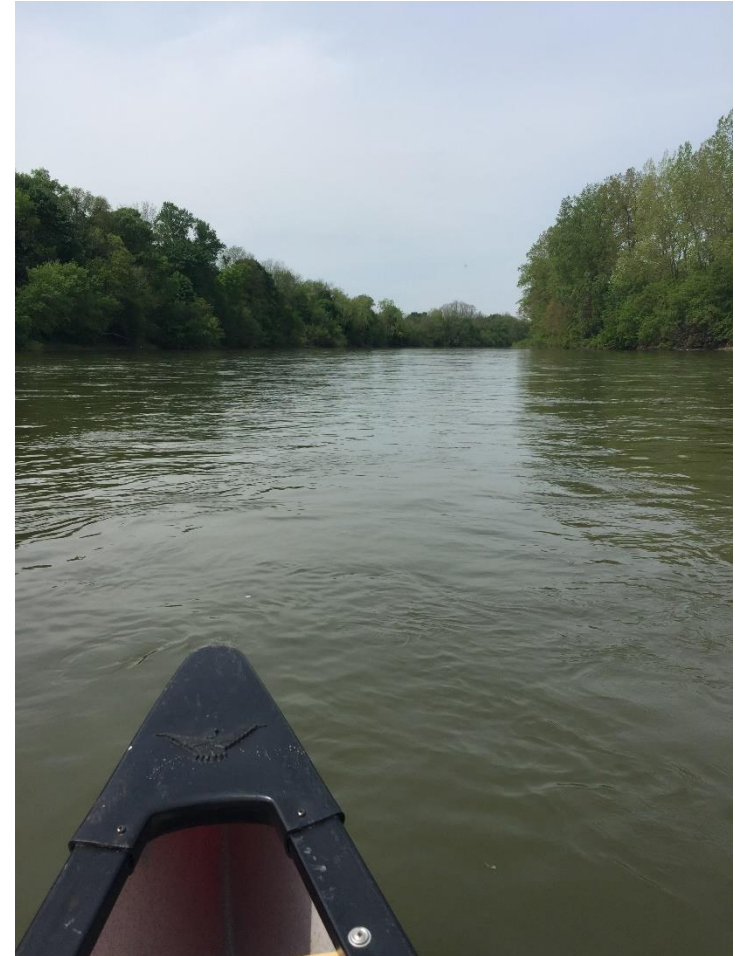
# Pop-up Events

- September 26, 2017: Agency Advisory Committee Report presented to CWC
- September 28, 2017: Presentation at EEPAC
- October 2017: Public Information Centre to present alternatives for Springbank Dam and receive public input
- Evaluation of Alternatives
- Q4 2017: Present preferred alternative for Springbank Dam to CWC
