- approval hereby given BE CONDITIONAL upon the Corporation entering into a formal d) contract or having a purchase order relating to the subject matter of this approval.

## **BACKGROUND**

**Purchasing Process** 

Four (4) bids were received as a result of this tender call April 18, 2012 as summarized in Appendix "B" attached.

Dufferin Construction Company was the low bid and meets all the terms, conditions and specifications of T12-66.

**Purpose** 

The purpose of the Mill and Overlay program is to repair or patch road sections primarily on main commuter routes. The program is part of city wide maintenance activities where no other sub surface work or concrete work is planned.
