- Process of adding new or replacement locations – distance separation for schools, daycares, places of worship and residential land uses
- “No Touch” regulations maintained

- Consolidation of categories



### Commercial Parking Facilities

- Form and content of signage
- Prescribe maintenance standards



### Contractors

- Driveway contractors
- Roofers
- Pool installers
- Mobile sign installation
- Plumbing / drain layer contractors



### Donation Bins

- Permission of property owner
- Standards around cleanliness



### Door to Door Sales

- Maintain a list of employees
- Police Record Checks
- Identification



### TOBACCO / E-CIGARETTE

- Compliance with Provincial and Federal health related regulations



### Food Premise

- Consolidation of eating establishments and food shops



### Lodging Houses

- Compliance with Property Standards, Fire Code



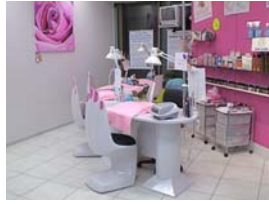
### Payday Loan Business

- Post interest rate information
- Information on money management support and debt counselling



### Personal Service Establishments

- Health related regulations regarding cleanliness



### Pet Shops

- Limit the source of companion animals for retail sale to registered rescues, humane societies and animal shelters
- Maintain a list of permitted animals for sale



### Public Halls

- Placing conditions on the licence to address the potential nuisances



### Refreshment Vehicles

- Consolidation of categories
- Use of regulations under delegated authority



### Seasonal Sales Businesses

- Signage
- Pedestrian/vehicular obstruction



### Second Hand Stores / Salvage Yard

- Police record checks
- Verify identity
- Submission of records to LPS
- Hold period – five days



## Unsolicited towing and storage

- Required signage
- Information provided to LPS
- Format of logbook
