By-law No. L-128

A by-law to amend By-law No. L-128-117 entitled
“A by-law for licensing, regulating and governing
persons who carry on the business of leasing
mobile signs”.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London wishes to amend By-law No. L-128-117 entitled “A by-law for licensing, regulating and governing persons who carry on the business of leasing mobile signs”;

AND WHEREAS section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. Section 7 of the Mobile Sign Business Licensing By-law L-128-117 is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and by replacing it with the following new section 7:

7. (1) Every licence issued under this By-law shall, unless revoked or surrendered at an earlier date, expire on the date indicated on the face of the licence but in no case shall the term of the licence exceed one year.

(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1) unless revoked or surrendered:

- (i) any licence issued in 2017 for the 2017 licence year shall be deemed to expire on April 2, 2018 at 11:59 p.m.;
- (ii) any new licence issued during the period from January 1, 2018 to April 2, 2018 for the 2018 licence year shall be expire on January 31, 2019 at 11:59p.m.

2. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the day it is passed.
