Bill No. 2017

By-law No. L-6-

A by-law to amend By-law No. L-6 entitled "A by-law to provide for the licensing and regulation of various businesses".

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London wishes to amend By-law L-6 entitled "A by-law to provide for the licensing and regulation of various businesses";

AND WHEREAS section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

- 1. Subsection 2.6(3) of the Business Licensing By-law L-6 is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and by replacing it with the following new subsection 2.6(3) as follows:
 - "2.6(3) (a) A licence issued under this By-law shall be valid only for the period of time for which it is issued. All licences issued under this By-law shall expire annually on December 31 at 11:59 pm. An application for a renewal shall be delivered to the Licence Manager on or before the expiry date of the licence being renewed.
 - (b) notwithstanding paragraph (a), unless revoked or surrendered:
 - (i) any licence issued under this By-law in 2017 for the 2017 licence year shall be deemed to expire on April 2, 2018 at 11:59 p.m.; and
 - (ii) any new licence issued under this By-law during the period from January 1, 2018 to April 2, 2018 for the 2018 licence year shall expire on January 31, 2019 at 11:59 p.m."
- 2. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the day it is passed.
